Wednesday, 6 April	End vote	Current rules do not specify how long the second round should take
Thursday, 7 April	Notification to members about the validity (and possibly results) of the vote	See <u>article 5.3</u>
Wednesday, 20 April	Voting Process Manager distributes ballots	
Thursday, 21 April	Start Round Two (in case round 1 was not valid)	
Thursday, 5 May	End Round two	
Friday, 6 May	Voting Process Manager announces the results
