FY23 Operating Plan (con'd)

 Functional Activities: Community Engagement and Services: Public Responsibility and Support

 \$1.7M allocated to these initiatives designed to increase diversity and lower barriers to participation. This directly addresses various MSM issues* and dovetails with various recommendations from WS2. Funding in this area should be increased to \$2.2M with \$.5M made available for special education and recruitment programs suggested by the community.

FY23 Operating Plan (cont'd)

 Functional Activities: Community Engagement and Services: Public Responsibility and Support (con't)

 Education tools such as Internet Governance Schools -- both in-person and virtual – and the volunteers who organize them should be supported. These activities provide group experience and have been very successful in educating potential recruits -- particularly for civil society and end user constituencies. ICANN Learn does not provide the same start-up motivation.
