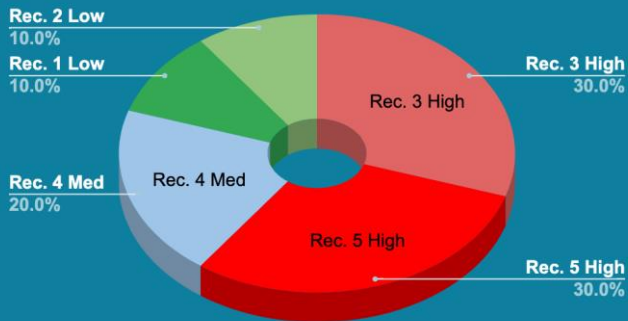

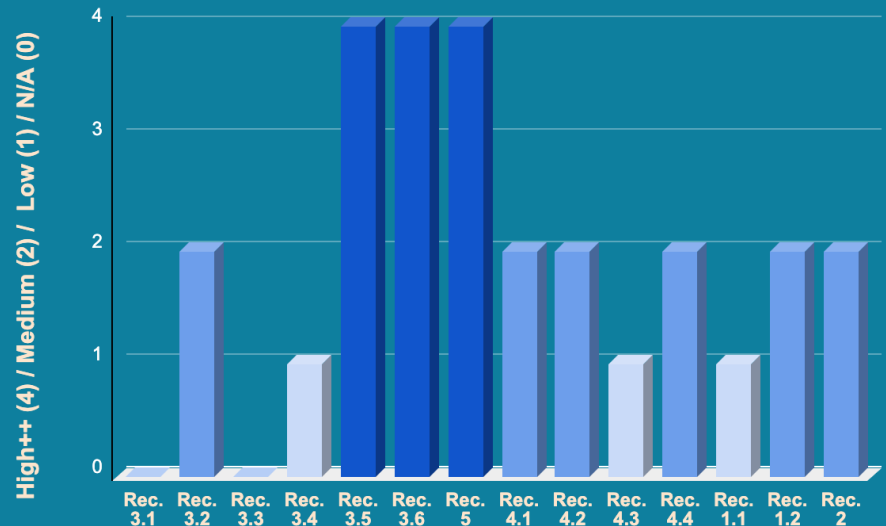
ATRT3 Recommendations prioritized by ATRT

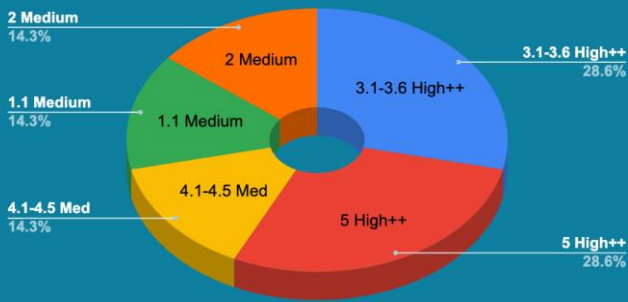

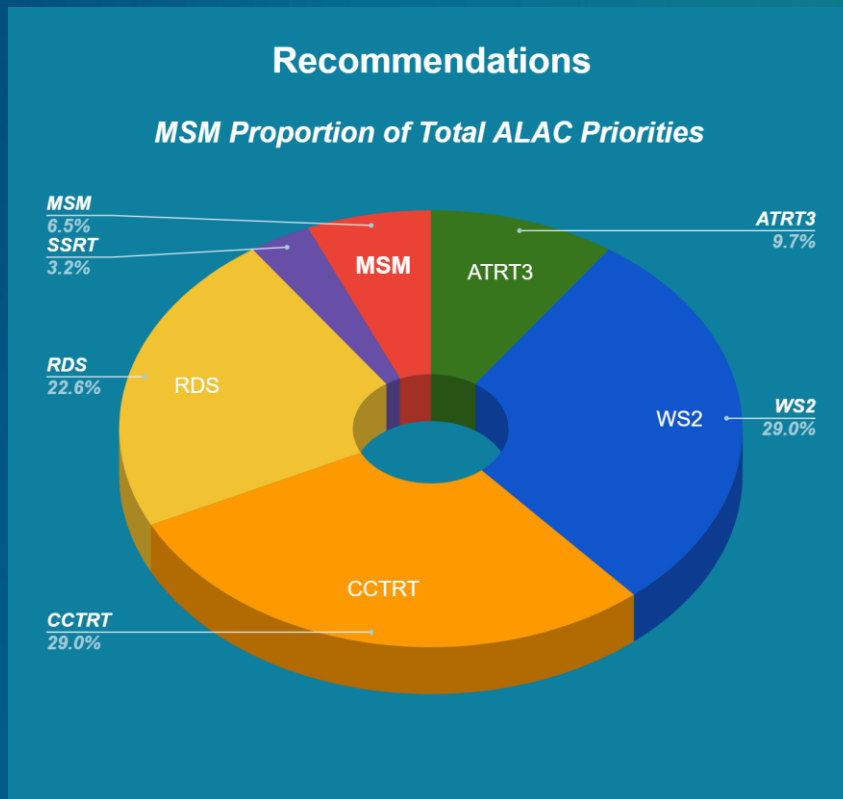
ATRT3 Recommendations prioritized by ALAC

APAT priority Levels of the ATRT3 Recommendations

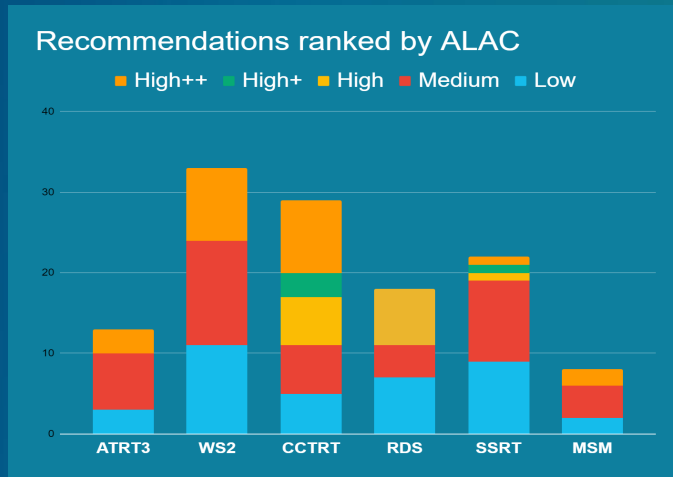

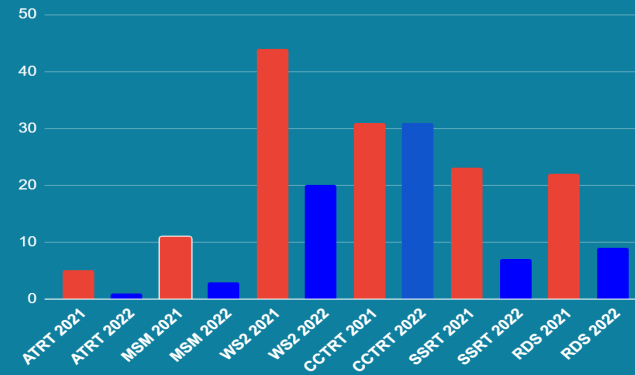
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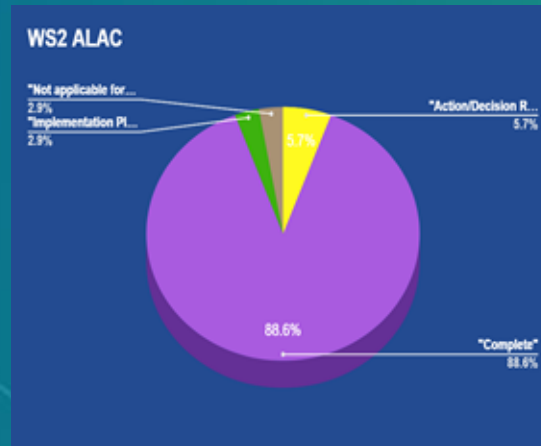
Recommendations and Outputs of the ALAC Prioritization Assessment Tool (APAT) – WS2.



Number of Remaining Recommendations as of 08/2021 and 03/2022

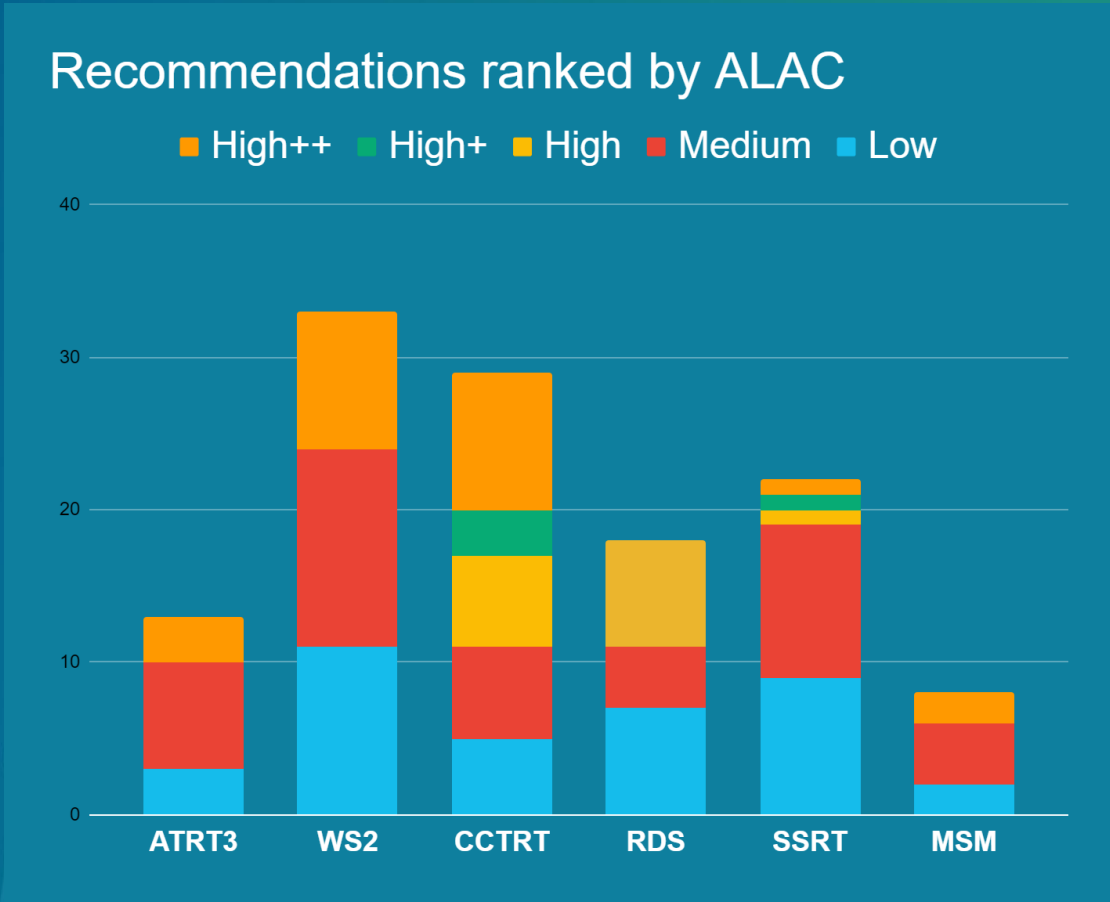

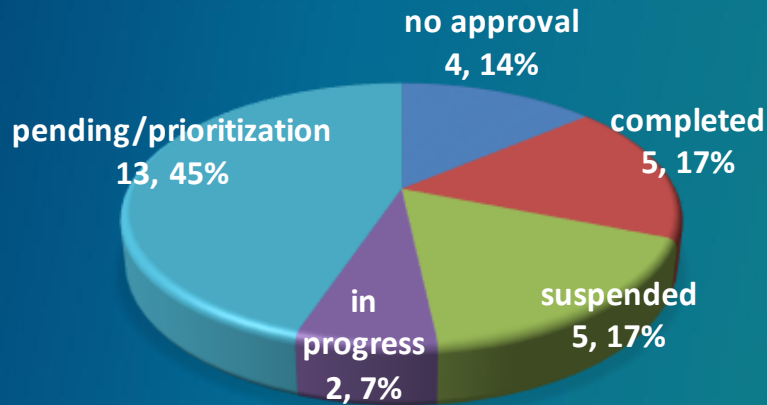
Current status of AC specific WS2 implementation End Feb22

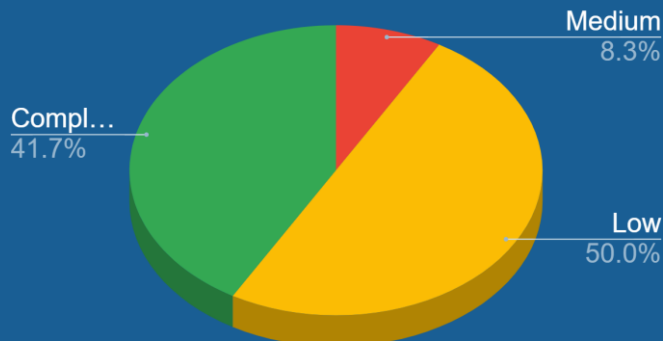

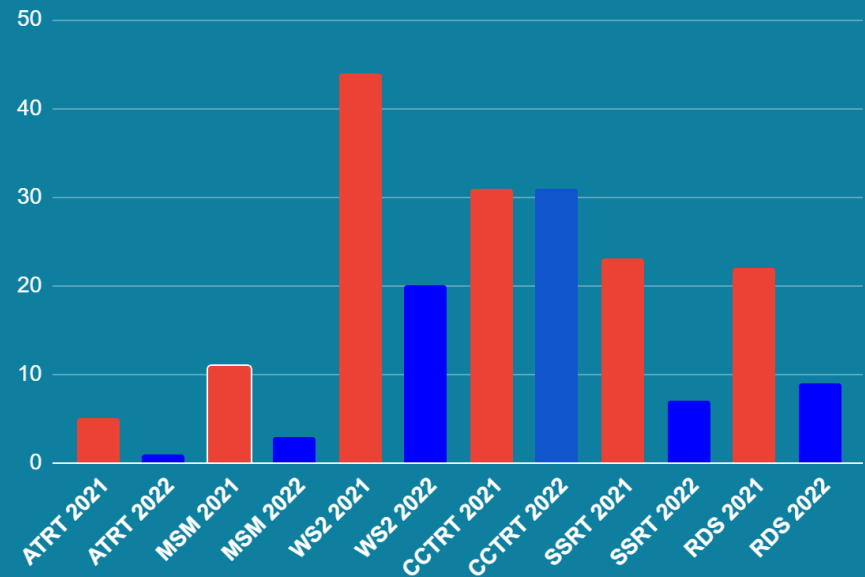

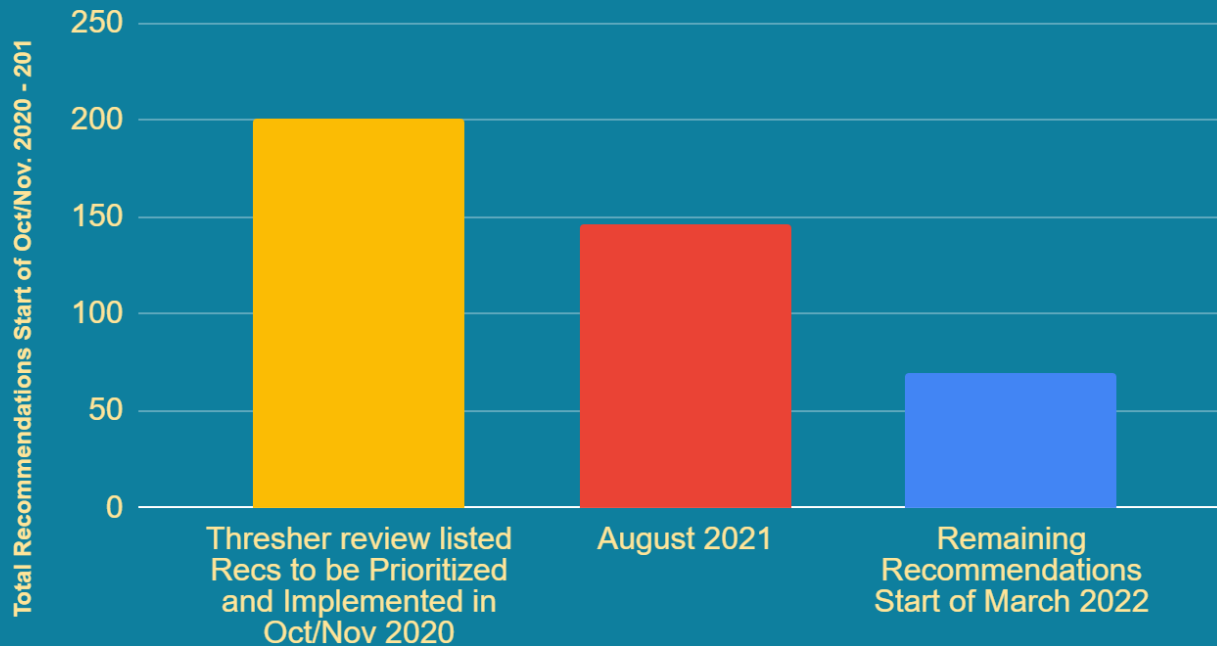
Number of Remaining Recommendations as of 08/2021 and 03/2022



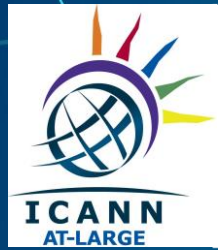

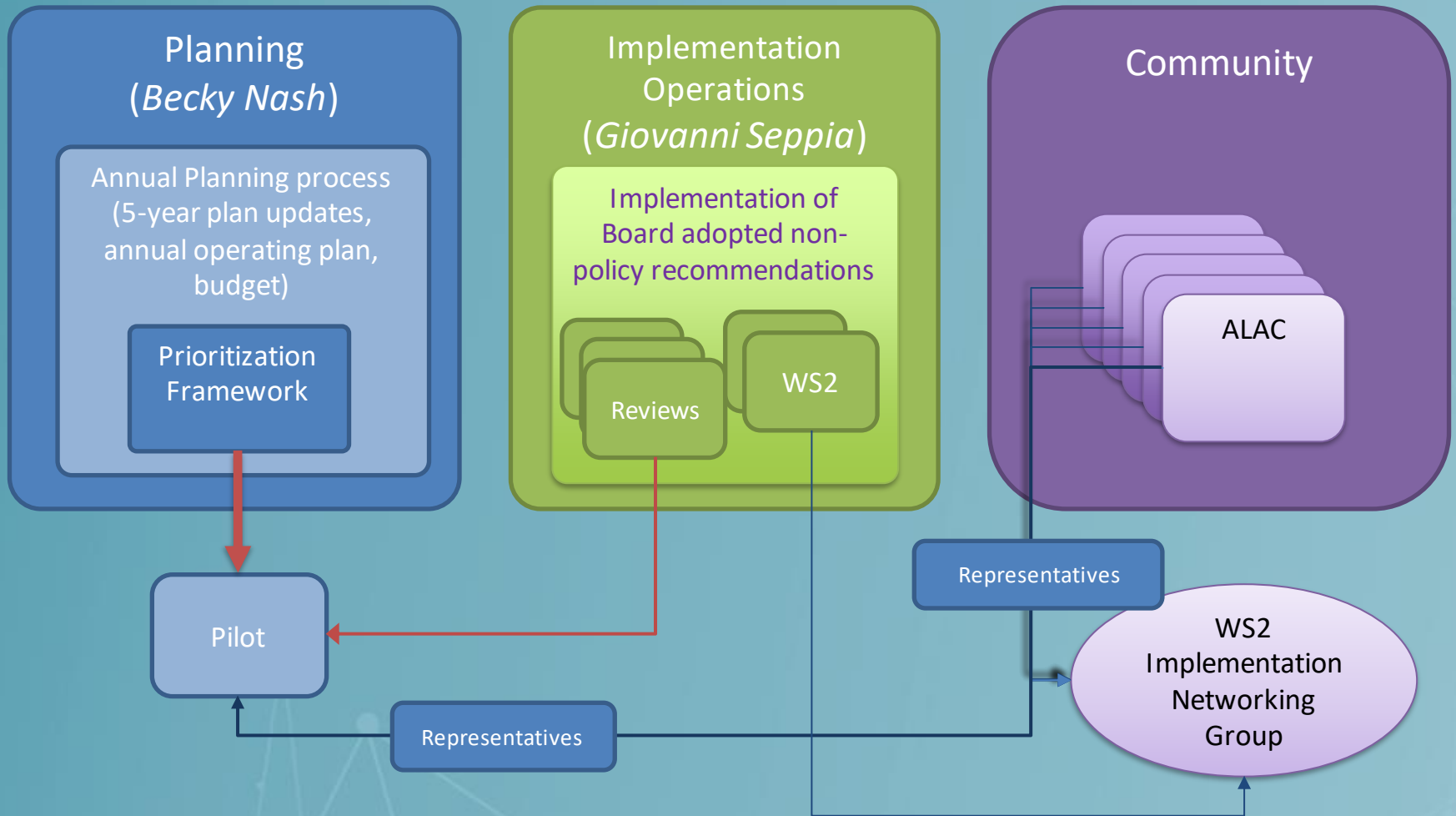

Planning Prioritization Framework and Pilot

- **Project:** “Planning at ICANN” is one of the 15 operating initiatives in ICANN’s Operating Plan for FY21 and FY22.
 - A component of this operating initiative is to deliver a draft prioritization framework as an improvement of ICANN’s overall planning process.
- **Accountability:** ICANN’s planning department is leading this operating initiative and the delivery of the draft prioritization framework.
- **Deliverable:** A draft prioritization framework to be used during the annual planning process.
- **Pilot:** Org proposes conducting a pilot on review recommendations to test the draft framework.

Implementation Operations focus
