On behalf of Maureen Hilyard, Chair of the ALAC, we would like to announce that the 2022 call for nominations is now open for positions to be filled as ALAC Members, RALO Leaders and ALAC Delegates to the NomCom.

Positions Open:

Please refer to the <u>2022 ALAC and RALO Elections</u>, <u>Selections and Appointments Workspace</u> for a comprehensive list of all available positions and whether current holders of the positions are eligible for re-selection.

Terms:

- ALAC: Terms for the ALAC will run from the end of the 2022 Annual General Meeting (AGM) to the end of the 2024 AGM.
- **RALO Leadership**: Terms for the RALO Leadership will be as noted on the individual RALO election pages. All terms will start at the end of the 2022 AGM.
- ALAC Delegates to the NomCom: Voting members of the NomCom are appointed for a one year term, starting at the close of the 2022 AGM and ending at the close of the 2023 AGM and may be re-appointed for a further term of one year subject to the requirement under the ICANN Bylaws. Each RALO may make one or more recommendations for the consideration of the ALAC. The appointment if NomCom delegates is carried out by the ALAC. The criteria for NomCom Delegates are shown at the end of this message.

Selection Schedule for ALAC Members, RALO Leadership, and ALAC Delegates to the NomCom:

- 18 April 2022 Announcement of call for nominations and Nominee's Statement. (Except for NARALO that requires a call for nominations 30 days before the start of the elections.)
- 18 April 2022 29 April 2022 Nomination period (nominations accepted for 10 working days).
- 6 May 2022 Deadline for nomination acceptances
- 9 May 2022 12 May 2022 Calls with the candidates if desired by the RALOs.
- 13 May 20 May 2022 Elections (If required, elections will begin no later than one week after the deadline for nomination acceptances and end no later than two weeks after that deadline).
- 2022 AGM [ICANN75] Newly elected ALAC Members and RALOs Leaders shall be seated at the end of the 2022 AGM following the close of the Board Meeting on 22 September 2022.

Process for Nominations:

All nominees are expected to submit a brief statement explaining why they believe they are a suitable candidate to <u>At-Large staff</u>. All nominees must also complete or update their Statement of Interest (see: <u>At-Large New SOIs Workspace</u>).

Nominations, including self-nominations, *mus*t be made directly to their RALO's mailing list and by sending a note to At-Large staff.

Criteria for NomCom Delegates:

The NomCom is responsible for selecting members of the ICANN Board, ALAC, ccNSO and GNSO. This is a very important function and all candidates should meet important criteria.

- Familiarity with the ICANN groups to which the NomCom appoints (Board, ALAC, GNSO, ccNSO).
- Ability to judge people (such as when interviewing and hiring).
- Comfortable and preferably fluent with English (listening, reading, speaking).
- Good on-line skills such as on Google & Social media.
- Time Commitment Must be willing to devote substantial time under tight deadlines (March-June). May involve travel to up to 4 meetings.
- Ability work in a group environment, standing up for what you believe in a discussion with other "strong" people, but at the same time, must be a good listener and be willing to change your mind if someone else has a good argument. Diplomacy is important.
