Discuss technical and operational registry topics, security, and other DNS-related work

Since 2006, Tech Day has been part of ICANN Public Meetings.

It provides a forum for both experienced participants and newcomers to meet and to present and discuss technical and operational registry topics, security, and other Domain Name System-related work.

During ICANN73, Tech Day focused on DNS Security Extensions (DNSSEC), DNS abuse prevention and mitigation, and other topics.

- Challenges facing registries and registrars in their combat against DNS abuse
- Basic algorithm for a prompt action in the case of identification of potentially malicious registrations
- Updates on the DNS Core Census project inaugurated at ICANN72
- Deployment of DMARC (Domain-Based Message Authentication, Reporting and Conformance) in the zones .BANK, .INSURANCE
- Round table on DNS Abuse agreed on the need to collaborate and join forces in order to counter new challenges associated with DNS Abuse

- ccNSO & DNS Abuse: current status, and the next steps.

DNS Abuse session

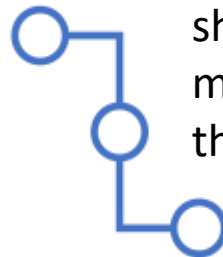

This session built on previous work during ICANN72 and a ccNSO workshop held in November 2021 when ccTLDs and the broader community suggested areas that the ccNSO should get involved in with respect to DNS abuse.

ccNSO DNS Abuse Steering Committee presented the roadmap and the ccNSO Council is expected to adopt it for implementation. Also, the Committee is to work on sharing information, best practices; identify channels for messaging; create an overview of existing metrics and all this aligned with the ccNSO role.



ccNSO Governance session

The ccNSO Guideline Review Committee (GRC) informed the ccNSO membership about the vote on the new ccNSO rules, which propose to replace the 2004 rules. Voting is expected to begin after ICANN73. The new rules would have a direct impact on the governance structure of the ccNSO, specifically on the respective roles and responsibilities of the ccNSO Council and ccNSO members.

In addition, the GRC launched a discussion on the ccNSO Conflict of Interest (COI) procedures to seek input from the ccNSO community and other stakeholders. The discussion revealed the need for ccNSO Councilors to put forward Statements of Interest, even if the position does not imply any material or financial aspects.
