IGLC Action Plan: Implementation

To be implemented asap

1. The IGLC sets up an IGLC sub-group which plans IGLC Sessions
2. The IGLC creates a heat map with hot IG-topics on a regional basis

Requires additional planning, but planning should start asap

1. A small team within the IGLC to provide ccTLD-relevant content related to IG, for a written (quarterly) update to be included in the ccNSO monthly newsletter
2. The IGLC provides more information to ccTLD community regarding IG-related events and topics relevant to ccTLDs. Potential channels are webinars, newsletter articles.

To be planned and implemented when times and resources are available

1. The IGLC identifies which IG-related groups within the ICANN ecosystem are relevant and why. Once this has been done, the IGLC appoints representatives to those groups.

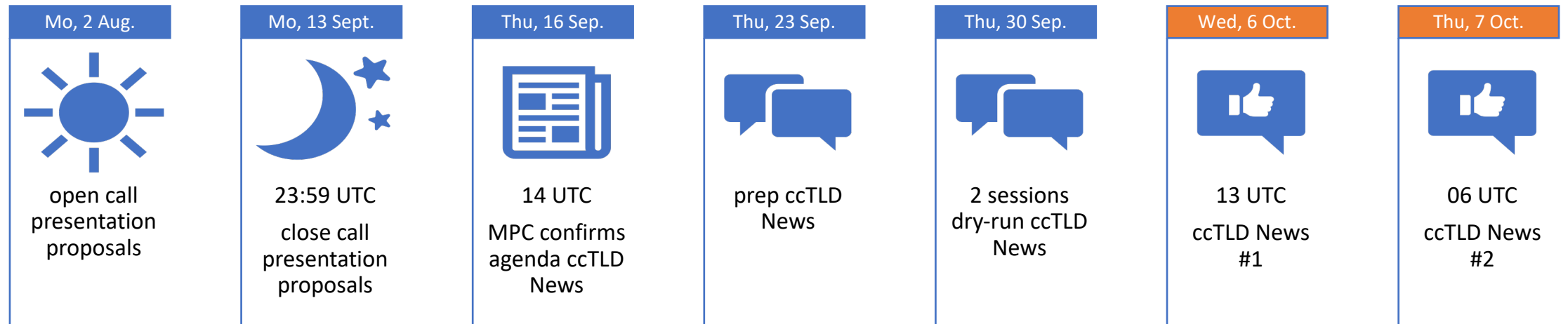
