Identify and address global challenges and opportunities within its remit by further developing early warning systems, such as ICANN org's Legislative and Regulatory Development Reports Continue to build alliances in the Internet ecosystem and beyond to raise awareness of and engage with global stakeholders about ICANN's mission and policymaking



CANADA: Political Landscape

- Minority government (Liberal/New Democratic Party)
- 2022 is a challenging year in most countries; Canada is no exception
- Newly elected opposition leader



CANADA: Legislation of Interest

- C-27: Three bills in one: Consumer Privacy Protection Act; Personal Information and Data Protection Tribunal Act; and the AI and Data Act Introduced and First Reading in the House on 16 June 2022 Second Reading not yet scheduled
- C-26: An Act Respecting Cybersecurity, amending the Telecom Act and making consequential amendments to other Acts
 Introduced and First Reading in the House on 14 June 2022
 Second Reading not yet scheduled
- Online Safety (formerly Online Harms Act)

 - Resolution 133, Role of administrations of Member States in the management of internationalized (multilingual) domain names
 - Resolution 146, Periodic Review of the International Telecommunication Regulations
