
## **Universal Acceptance Enables Digital Inclusivity**

- \*Consumer Choice
- \*Digital Inclusivity

- \*Multilingual Internet
- There are now more than **1,200 active gTLDs**, as well as country code top-level domains (ccTLDs) that are available in different scripts and that may be longer than three characters. These new TLDs represent cultures, brands, geographies, and special interests (e.g. . ใหย, .LONDON, .SPORT).
- Today, the Internet population is 4.5 billion active users, and at least one billion more are expected to come online by 2023. Through Universal Acceptance (UA), they will experience the full benefits of the Internet.
- The majority of the world does not speak English as a first language. In fact,
   only more than a third of the world population uses the Latin alphabet in English, while there are billions of people who prefer to read and write in Arabic, Ethiopic, Chinese, Cyrillic, or other scripts.




#### **Global Internet Users**





## **Africa Region**

- Around 1.2 billion people, ~77% of whom do not use the internet
- Main scripts being used in Africa are:
   Latin (English and French), Ethiopic and Arabic based.





## **UA Provides Business Opportunities**

- \* Competitive Advantage \* 9.8+ Billion Opportunity \* Reduce Technical Debt \* Social Responsibility \* Serve Local/Global Audiences
  - Potential to unlock billions in revenue from untapped customers.
  - A UASG study, conducted in 2017, found that the Universal Acceptance of domain names is a \$9.8+ billion opportunity, which is a conservative estimate.
  - UA –ready systems will have a first-mover advantage and the potential to capture new increasing revenue streams.
  - The investment to update systems is far outweighed by the revenue potential from becoming UA-ready.



## **UA Delivers Career Opportunities**

\* Competitive Differentiator \* Skill Development \* Global User Experience

- UA is the new competitive differentiator every developer should have in their skill set.
- Becoming proficient in UA does not require learning a new category of coding, but rather builds upon existing skill sets to expand systems to recognize and support URLs and email addresses in all character lengths, and scripts.







## By the Numbers


**1,180** TLD zones

#### **Next Steps and Community Support**

#### 1) **UASG and ICANN** continue to undertake:

- Gap analysis of social media, browsers, programming languages, EAI Tools, etc.
- Remediation efforts like engaging technology forums (e.g. Github) and bug reporting.
- Training and outreach through local initiatives and ambassadors.
- 2) The ICANN community can help address UA-readiness and lead by example:
- Raise awareness of the technical problems within the community.
- Upgrade and use UA ready systems as a community to create the necessary demand, e.g. upgrade email servers, use email in local languages.
- Advocate more broadly to support UA in their systems (e.g. in e-govt. services; the private sector organizations, etc.).

Such activities can be done in collaboration with UA Local Initiative and UA Ambassadors.
