What has the Community achieved in 4 years?

ICANN has enhanced registration data privacy measures to meet privacy laws and users expectations

- ❖ **ICANN EPDP on Temp. Spec. for gTLD registration data**

- ❖ **Community action included identifying:**
 - purposes for data registration collection
 - data elements for public display
 - ICANN policies that require updates based on the new registration data policy

- ❖ **Benefits**
 - Currently public data does not include personal information of registrants
 - All users around the globe enjoy same data privacy measures

- ❖ **Currently**
 - Public Comment intended to gather input on the implementation plan for the EPDP-Temp. Spec.
 - A proposal for a Proof of Concept (SSAD light)
 - Scoping team on accuracy

Impact of GDPR on ICANN – 4 years on

How do we measure the effectiveness of the GDPR and assess its impact on ICANN?

- GDPR has been presented by policy makers as net welfare enhancing policy
- The derive to protect policy cannot become absolute and lack balance with other rights
- How do we measure the impact of the new registration policy on data privacy?
- How do we identify the impact of current registration data on public WHOIS information and end users security
- The need to know current experience of parties seeking registration data to ensure the current system is operating effectively
