1. Welcome, roll call - Matt

2. Consensus call on the Perspective Study and Case Study documents – Matt

Matt reminded the Group that he will continue to review and accept any changes to the [Perspective Study](#) and [Case Study](#) suggested by the DG members. No one had any additional comments during the meeting.

3. Continue discussion on Workflow Table Exercises - Matt

Matt briefly walked the group through [the slides](#) summarizing what was discussed in the last meeting for those who did not attend the previous Discussion Group call. Comments and questions asked by the Discussion Group members during the meeting:

- Anne asked about the function of reviewing any collision incidents and whether this group would have to make a recommendation on what work report should be filed. Jim pointed out that the NCAP Study 2 won't suggest any requirements to implement by ICANN. Matt requested to add an action item to address the name collision reporting function in the NCAP Study 2.
- Anne had also a question about the necessity to provide a notification to the end user about a name collision incident.

4. Summary of action items and decisions – Matt

Action item: Discussion Group to document in the workflow the ways in which the workflow meets the relevant implementation guidance from the SubPro final report.

Action item: Discussion Group to consider providing implementation recommendation guidance in the report.

Action item: Discussion Group to address the name collision reporting function in the NCAP Study 2.
