









Distributed, resilient network



Council composed of 21 members—divided into 2 houses (contracted and non-contracted parties) who work on generic top-level domain (gTLD) naming policies (e.g., .com, new gTLDs). **ICANN** GAC Governmental Advisory Committee

Provides advice on public policy issues, particularly on interactions with policies and national laws or international agreements





Voices the interests of the individual Internet user and is composed of 15 members—2 from each of the five Regional At-Large Organizations (RALOs) and 5 appointed bt the ICANN Nomitating Committee. It is supported by over 200 At-Large Structures (ALSes) and volunteers.


DNS Security Threat Mitigation Program




