Next Steps - continued

- After receiving input from the ICANN Community on the Draft Framework, the group will reconvene prior to issuing a Final Framework.
- The three groups that are participating in the dialogue (i.e. the ALAC, GAC and GNSO Council) will each use their own internal processes to signal whether they agree with the proposed approach in the Final Framework.
- If agreement is reached, the Final Framework will be submitted to the GNSO Council to set the basis for a future policy process on Closed Generic gTLDs.
- If no agreement is reached, this issue will be submitted to the Board for consideration.
