#### Questions related to resources were raised

- 1. Do we have existing simple materials for any of us to use in engaging any entity/group listed above? Covering IDNs, DNS Abuse? We should have the same for UA (via UASG) and DNSSEC (GSE). Can we leverage GSE in respect of IDNs at least, since ICANN is pushing the IDN agenda?
- 2. Is the intention for an APRALO ABR to be crafted to fund travel to some of the above engagement opportunities? Aside from materials, that is. Or CROP?

### Suggestions

There is a need to create relevant online resource material on IDNs, DNS Abuse, that is easy to understand and engaging. It could be an initiative led by APRALO could create these materials and the GSE/ ICANN team could be the knowledge partners in this endeavour.

Once created we could explore creating it in non english languages as per requirement. The APRALO team would also need the support of graphic designers who could convert the text into easy to understand and attractive infographics.

This could possibly be a proposal for seeking ABR.
