ALAC Statement on the Request for Community Input on SAC054: Domain Name Registration Data Model

Introduction

Julie Hammer, ALAC Liaison to the SSAC and At-Large member from the Asian, Australasian and Pacific Islands Regional At-Large Organization (APRALO), composed an initial draft of this Statement after discussion of the topic within At-Large and discussion of the topic on the At-Large Mailing Lists.

On 7 July 2012, this Statement was posted on the <u>At-Large Request for Community Input on SAC054</u> - Domain Name Registration Data Model Workspace.

On 10 July 2012, Olivier Crépin-Leblond, Chair of the ALAC, requested ICANN Policy Staff in Support of ALAC to send a call for comments on the draft Statement to all At-Large members via the ALAC-Announce Mailing List and the At-=Large Technical Issues Mailing List.

On 16 July 2012, the Chair requested that the call for comments be extended until 23 August 2012.

On 30 August 2012, a version incorporating the comments received was posted and the Chair requested that Staff open a five-day ALAC ratification on the Statement.

On 7 September 2012, Staff confirmed that the online vote resulted in the ALAC endorsing the Statement with 12 votes in favor, 0 votes against, and 0 abstentions. You may review the result independently under: https://www.bigpulse.com/pollresults?code=2621WMBepT3xcihDcglwuTUb.

The Chair then requested that the Statement be transmitted to Patrik Fältström, the Chair of SSAC, and Jim Galvin, the Vice-Chair, of SSAC.

ALAC Statement on the Request for Community Input on SAC054: Domain Name Registration Data Model

SAC054, released on 11 June 2012, proposes a standards-based, structured, and extensible model for the recording of Domain Name Registration Data. (DNRD). This DNRD Model is presented as a candidate or strawman for Community discussion and as a basis for further development. The SSAC seeks Community feedback on its completeness and utility.

The ALAC commends SSAC for this initiative and supports its intent. Jim Galvin (Deputy Chair of SSAC) briefed At-Large Community Members on SAC054 during a Webinar on 20 July 2012 and the following points were noted during discussion:

- The data model should include elements that could be used for privacy controls.
- It would be useful for SAC054 to be translated into other languages, in particular Spanish and French.

Spanish and French translations have subsequently been done and these are posted on the <u>At-Large Policy Development</u> <u>Page</u> as well as the <u>SSAC Documents Page</u>.

No further comment on SAC054 has been received from At-Large Community Members. However, the ALAC will be interested to review future iterations of the Domain Name Registration Model as it evolves.
