# **AFRALO Monthly Report - June 2013**

AFRALO's main activities of June 2013 are following:

#### 1. Program for the Virtual capacity building for African ALS

Following the ALS survey, it was noted that low understanding of the debates concerning the issues addressed by ICANN as well as the terminologies used, that it was necessary to put in place a virtual training for the benefit of the ALS to complete the Dakar Training. It is for this reason and in the framework of the preparation of the London At-Large Summit in 2014 that Afralo organized, with the assistance of ICANN staff, virtual trainings. Two sessions were held in June:

## a. The AFRALO Showcase:

## b. The Joint AFRALO/AfrICANN Meeting in Durban

The theme of this meeting was decided in consultation with the members of the African community in ICANN. This meeting will be held on Wednesday, 17 July 2013, under the theme: "Evaluation of the AFRALO-AfrICANN initiative after 8 meetings".

An inventory of the various statements of AFRALO/AfrICANN meetings as well as the impact they have had on the ICANN will be reviewed at the meeting by Afralo members with the presence of the CEO and the Chairman of the Board of ICANN.
