

AFRALO Activity Report (November 2012)

The main AFRALO activities during the month of November 2012 were related to the following issues:

1. Application of the « Association Tchadienne pour la Promotion et de Développement de l'Internet au Tchad (ATPDIT) »

AFRALO had decided to reject the application of ATPDIT as it was presented. Therefore, a request for information was sent to the ISOC to know the status of the Chadian chapter.

The staff was informed that the ISOC Chad is under restructuring, it is temporarily led by Mr. Oumar Ousmar and the data presented in the original application are obsolete. As a result, it has been suggested that another application will be submitted to AFRALO when the chapter will be officially renewed.

2. AFRALO ALS activities

During the AFRALO November teleconference, it was suggested by most of the participants to create a WIKI page for the publication of the African ALS activities. To this end, the ICANN staff has created a wiki page:
