The main AFRALO activities during the month of December 2012 were related to the following issues:

1. Appointment of Pierre Dandjinou as Vice President of ICANN for Africa

Following his appointment as Vice President of ICANN for Africa, Mr. Pierre Dandjinou, who used to be the founder of AFRALO, has been invited to the AFRALO conference call held on 5 December 2012. He assured the participants that he would like to work closely with all African constituents at ICANN and particularly with AFRALO for the implementation of the African Strategy. Topics were discussed such as Ambassadors programs, capacity building program for AFRALO ALSes, etc. ..

2. Recent and future activities of AFRALO members
