GNSO Reform: Representation

Joint users proposal

- 6 suppliers, 6 Commercial users, 6 Noncommercial users

Baseline proposal

- 4 Registries, 4 Registrars, 4 Commercial, 4 Noncommercial, 3 Nomcom

The evil proposal

- 4 Registries, 4 Registrars, 5 Commercial, 3 Noncommercial, 3 Nomcom

Opening up to individuals

- Both Commercial and Noncommercial stakeholder groups should open up to individuals
 - Examples of “noncommercial” individuals:
 - a personal domain for an email account
 - a domain name holder with a family web site or blog
 - individual academics or noncommercial organization members who lack the standing to get their organization to formally join

NCUC Experiment

- Provisional individual representation
 - Register as provisional member
 - Participation on discuss list
 - No voting
 - Status reassessed after Board decides on GNSO structural reform
 - Criteria:
 - Not currently members of any other GNSO constituency (or SO?)
 - Their interest in domain name policy relates to their individual use and the noncommercial, public interest aspects of policy
