Re: dotMobi Policy Advisory Board

Dear Ms Langdon-Orr,

I write to you in relation to the upcoming nominations/elections for the dotMobi Policy Advisory Board [PAB].

dotMobi is the Irish-based Registry for the .mobi domain and the PAB is made up of ten members, independent of dotMobi, that meet monthly [by teleconference] to advise on best-practice Registry policy as well as end-user issues relating to the mobile Internet.

As per PAB's Operating Rules and Procedures, five members of the PAB are elected by the .mobi Advisory Group [MAG] – see <http://www.advisorygroup.mobi/> for details on this organisation. The five non-MAG members of PAB are constituted as follows: one member shall be appointed by the ICANN At Large Advisory Committee [ALAC], one member shall be appointed by the ICANN GNSO Noncommercial Users Constituency [NCUC], and one member shall be appointed by the Registry contractor [Afilias]. The remaining two positions are intended to be representatives of individual Internet users and noncommercial NGOs.

The term of the current PAB expires on 1 December 2008 and new nominations are now being sought from the various membership categories, including the ALAC. [Current members are also able to stand again if so chosen]. To that end, I would be grateful if you could consult your Constituency to solicit an ALAC member or representative that would be interested in joining the PAB for 2009.

I would greatly appreciate it if you would be able to advise me of the 2009 PAB-ALAC member immediately following the ICANN meeting in Cairo. I will be in attendance at the ICANN meeting should you require any further information from me or please do not hesitate to contact me either by email or telephone.
