The main focus of our EURALO work should be:

- To broaden our basis and to involve more organisations and individuals all over Europe
- To obtain and transmit the end user perspective on the main issues that we are working on such as:

### **Group A**

- ✓ IPv4 and IPv6
- ✓ IDNs
- ✓ DNSSEC

### **Group B**

- ✓ New gTLDs
- ✓ Privacy and Whois
- ✓ Protection of Registrants in relation to Registrars (RAA amendments)
- ✓ Price development in the registration sphere
- ✓ DNS and Freedom of expression
- ✓ The primacy of the public interest

### **Group C**

- ✓ ICANN Geographic Regions (joint interest with the ccNSO): what countries in?
- ✓ User's participation models within ICANN structures
- ✓ JPA

The General Assembly will set-up and/or delete/add the issues of this above-mentioned list.

Our aim is to create working groups/task forces on the different topics submitting working papers to the board and EURALO-list. ALSes who have already focused on some of these issues and are somehow specialised should take a thematic lead on it.
