Heat map: Topic prioritisation

BACKGROUND. IGLC held a working session at ICANN75, where the group further explored the topics on the heat map from a regional perspective. This resulted in a table, which was circulated end 2022 to the IGLC mailing list for further comments or possible additions. To further prioritize the list of topics, and to determine the next actions for the benefit of ccTLDs globally, the IGLC leadership team invited the IGLC membership to participate in a survey, and to sort the different topics into their appropriate baskets.

1. **Cybersecurity:** child safety online, critical infrastructure, cyberconflict and warfare, cybercrime, encryption, network security
2. **Development:** digital divide, access, sustainability
3. **Economic:** e-commerce, virtual currencies, consumer protection, taxation
4. **Human rights:** freedom of expression, privacy and data protection, rights of children, rights of persons with disabilities, gender rights
5. **Infrastructure:** Critical internet resources, telecommunications infrastructure, digital standards
6. **Legal and regulatory:** copyright, trademarks, jurisdiction, arbitration, internet intermediaries, labour law
7. **Sociocultural:** content policy, cultural diversity, digital identities, multilingualism, online education
8. **Other:** If you think that the topic should assigned to a different category please specify
