Objectives of UA Day

- In order to mobilize the technical community to become UA-ready, Universal Acceptance Steering Group (UASG) proposes to organize a UA Day.
- The UA Day aims to rally local, national, regional, and global organizations and community to create a "buzz" around adopting UA.
- Organizations to propose one of the following:
 - Organize a UA Awareness session: provide a high-level overview of UA and Email Address Internationalization (EAI), the benefits of being UA-ready, basic technical concepts related to UA, and next steps to become UA-ready.
 - Organize a UA Technical Training session: provide in-depth training on becoming EAI-ready for email system administrators and on becoming UA-ready for developers.
 - Organize a UA Strategy session: discuss appropriate mechanisms to promote UA adoption at the regional level.



Strategy for UA Day

- Plan and support UA awareness and technical training events on or around the UA Day (28 March 2023).
 - Local/National
 - Regional
 - Global
- Encourage UA Ambassadors, UA Local Initiatives, ICANN, and interested global partners and organizations to host UA Day events.
- Reach out to the ICANN community and ALAC, RALOs, and ALSes to host events.



UA Day Events: Call for Proposals and Responses

- A <u>call for UA Day event proposals</u> was published on 21 December 2022. Proposals were collected through an online form on https://UniversalAcceptance.day.
- The last date for accepting the proposals was 31 January 2023. Successful proposals are published on the UA Day webpage at https://UniversalAcceptance.day.
- A total of 89 proposals for local/national and regional UA Day events were received by 31 January 2023.



- Of the 89 proposals, a total of 50+ events shortlisted from 40+ locations. The main UA Day event hosted by Govt. of India.



Attendance and Outreach of UA Day Events


- Based on the 27 UA Day events reported till 24 April, 2023:
 - There were 6661 attendees in these events.
 - Two large events in China and India, each with around 2000 attendees (physical and virtual).
 - The events were held in more than 18 languages, including Arabic, Armenian, Bengali, Chinese, Dutch, English, French, Hindi, Myanmar, Nepal, Portuguese, Russian, Sinhala, Spanish, Swahili, Thai, Turkish, and Urdu.
- Two press releases were published by ICANN:
 - UA Day: Global Effort to Drive a More Inclusive Internet on 9 March 2023
 - Charting Towards a Multilingual and Inclusive Internet on 24 March 2023
 - These press releases garnered more than 1,500 "pickups" by various global media outlets.
- ICANN conducted extensive social media engagement leading up to and on UA Day, including paid social campaigns on Twitter and Facebook.
 - The paid campaigns resulted in over one million impressions/reach and over 3,500 link clicks to the UA Day page.
