Roles

The officers of AFRALO are a Chairperson, a Vice Chairperson and a Secretariat.

- **Chairperson**

- Shall be elected by the Members of AFRALO and shall serve a term of office of two years.
- He or she shall act as Chairperson at all AFRALO Meetings, coordinate the AFRALO activities and represent the AFRALO in its dealings with outside entities.

- **Vice Chairperson**

- Shall be elected by the Members of AFRALO and shall serve a term of office of two years.
- He or she shall assist the Chair and replace him/her where he/she is unavailable.

Roles

At-Large Advisory Committee (ALAC) roles.

- **ALAC Member**

- The ALAC shall consist of two members selected by each of the Regional At-Large Organizations (RALOs) established according to Section 12.2(d)(vii)
- Delegates are expected to actively participate in all aspects of the Committee's work. This includes some qualitative commitments and quantitative requirements.
 - Qualitative: Participating in activities, providing feedback on matters, serving as a liaison to the public, etc
 - Quantitative: Casting votes on ALS accreditation, attend $\frac{2}{3}$ calls in 6 month period, etc

- **ALAC Voting Delegate to the NomCom**

- Five members selected by the Nominating Committee. (one for each geographic region)
- The NomCom is responsible for selecting members of the ICANN Board, ALAC, ccNSO and GNSO. This is a very important function and all candidates should meet important criteria.

ALAC Selection Timetable for 2023 ALAC Members (DRAFT)

- 17 April 2023 - Announcement of call for nominations and Nominee's Statement.
- 17 April – 28 April 2023 - Nomination period (nominations accepted for 10 working days).
- 5 May 2022 - Deadline for nomination acceptances
- 9 May 2023 - 11 May 2023- Calls with the candidates if desired by the RALOs (currently here)
- 12 May - 19 May 2023 - Elections (If required, elections will begin no later than one week after the deadline for nomination acceptances and end no later than two weeks after that deadline).
- 2023 AGM [ICANN78] - Newly elected ALAC Members and RALOs Leaders shall be seated at the end of the 2023 AGM following the close of the Board Meeting on 26 October 2023.
