Summary of Board Resolution



Board Resolution: RPM PDP Final Report

- The ICANN Board adopted the GNSO-approved final recommendations from the Phase 1 PDP in January 2022. (See Resolutions 2022.01.16.05 2022.01.16.11)
- In <u>adopting</u> all 35 recommendations from the Final <u>Report</u>, the Board <u>noted</u> that implementation of the recommendations could be divided into several categories:
 - 1) Recommendations that call for updates to existing operational practices or documentation concerning the RPMs a total number of sixteen (16) recommendations;
 - 2) Recommendations to maintain the status quo (i.e., maintaining the Phase 1 RPMs as implemented for the 2012 New gTLD Program) a total number of nine (9) recommendations;
 - 3) Recommendations that require substantial resourcing, and involvement of multiple stakeholders to implement – a total number of six (6) recommendations; and
 - 4) Recommendations affecting subsequent round(s) of new gTLDs a total number of four (4) recommendations.



Expectations and Process



Expectations & Process: Role of the IPT

Implementation Project Team (IPT):

- ICANN Staff-only IPT is recruited to assist in project planning and policy drafting.
- Project Manager will lead the IPT and IRT to implement the policy recommendations.
- IPT will design and build an implementation plan.
- IPT will set clear expectations and deadlines for IRT feedback on implementation materials.
- IPT will provide regular status updates and share relevant materials with the IRT.
- IPT, in consultation with the IRT, will conduct appropriate outreach to the community at critical milestones.
- IPT will schedule IRT meetings and distribute agenda and relevant documents at least 24 hours prior to each meeting.
- IPT will publish work products on the IRT wiki space.



Expectations & Process: Role of the IRT

Implementation Review Team (IRT):

- Is convened by the GNSO Council and returns to the Council for any additional guidance as required.
- Typically consists of, but will not be limited to:
 - Volunteers who were also involved in the development of the recommendations,
 - Where relevant, technical or subject-matter experts and contracted parties who can assist staff in the planning for the technical implementation of a policy change.
- Is expected to serve as a resource to Staff on the development of implementation details to ensure that the implementation conforms to the intent of the recommendations.
- Is <u>not</u> a forum for opening or revisiting policy discussions.
- Works with staff to develop and complete new Consensus Policy language.
- IRT members should have a good understanding of the contents of the RPM PDP Phase 1 Final Report.
- IRT members should provide feedback within deadlines requested by IPT.
- Operates with full transparency and in line with <u>IRT Principles & Guidelines</u>.



Expectations & Process: Implementation Activities

- 1. ICANN staff will draft implementation materials to kick off implementation discussions.
- 2. The draft implementation materials will be distributed to the IRT and call(s) will be held to clarify/improve the language consistent with the intent of the recommendations.
- 3. The proposed implementation materials will be posted for public comment.
- **4.** ICANN staff will adjust the proposed language based on public comments, in consultation with the IRT.
- **5.** The final product is then published/announced to the public and to relevant stakeholders.
