Understanding Universal Acceptance (UA)

Universal Acceptance (UA) is a foundational requirement for a truly multilingual Internet. It is also key to unlocking the potential of new generic top-level domains (gTLDs) to foster competition, consumer choice and innovation in the domain name industry. To achieve Universal Acceptance, Internet applications and systems must treat all TLDs in a consistent manner, including new gTLDs and Internationalized Domain Names (IDNs). Specifically, they must accept, validate, store, process and display all valid domain names.

The Universal Acceptance Steering Group (UASG) was founded in February 2015 and tasked with undertaking activities that will effectively promote the Universal Acceptance of all valid domain names and email addresses. The UASG is financially supported by the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN).

Hand Over Ceremony for New UASG Leaders



A hybrid hand over ceremony was held for the newly elected <u>UASG Leadership</u>, who start two-year terms. The event was physically held in Delhi, India, and others joined virtually through Zoom on 27 April 2023.

At the end of the election, one new Chair and three new Vice Chairs were selected. The new Chair is Anil Kumar Jain (India), CEO of the National Internet Exchange of India (NIXI). Anil is also the Chair of the UA Communications Working Group. The new Vice Chairs are Nabil Benamar

(Morocco), professor of computer sciences at Moulay Ismail University of Meknes. He is also the Chair of the Measurement Working Group. The other Vice Chair Haixin Duan (China), is also a professor, received his Ph.D in Computer Science from Tsinghua University in 2001, and currently leads the Network and Information Security Lab at the Institute for Network Sciences and Cyberspace of Tsinghua University. The other Vice Chair is Nitin Walia (India), Director of Data Xgen Technologies. Nitin is also the Vice Chair of the EAI Working Group.

The new leadership team took over from Dr. Ajay Data (India), Founder and CEO of XgenPlus, who served as Chair for two terms, and Vice Chairs, Abdalmonem Galila (Egypt), Numbering Planning Manager at the National Telecom Regulatory Authority of Egypt, and Dr. U.B. Pavanaja (India), CEO of Vishva Kannada Software.

Under Data's leadership the UASG worked to raise UA awareness by engaging with key stakeholders globally, developed numerous resources to aid organizations and businesses to become UA-ready, and conducted extensive analysis of the state of UA adoption. Data also oversaw the planning and implementation of the first-ever UA Day.

Universal Acceptance Day Launched

The first-ever UA Day was held on 28 March 2023. Organized by the UASG and ICANN, UA Day consisted of over 50 UA awareness and technical training sessions held in over 40 different countries and territories.

UA Day events were held in 21 languages, including Arabic, Armenian, Bengali, Chichewa, Chinese, Dutch, English, French, German, Hindi, Myanmar, Nepal, Persian, Portuguese, Russian, Sinhala, Spanish, Swahili, Thai, Turkish, and Urdu.

UA Day aimed to engage and mobilize top technical and language communities, companies, governments and DNS industry stakeholders to better understand the benefits of UA and how they can make their systems UA-ready.



The two-day event was hosted by India's Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) through the National Internet Exchange of India (NIXI). The event was supported by the ICANN and the UASG.

The keystone UA Day event was held in New Delhi, India.

In attendance at the event were ICANN Board Chair, Tripti Sinha; Interim President & CEO, Sally Costerton; ICANN Board Member, Edmon Chung; and ICANN APAC VP & MD, Jia Rong Low, among others.

The inaugural anchor UA Day event was chaired by India's Secretary for Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Shri Alkesh Kumar Sharma. More
