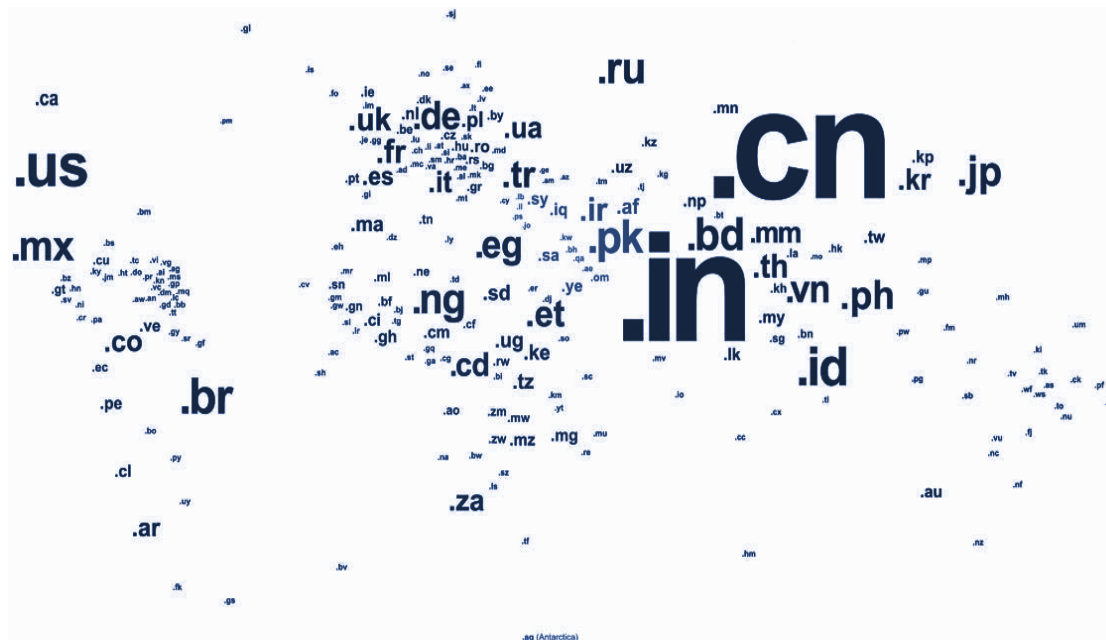




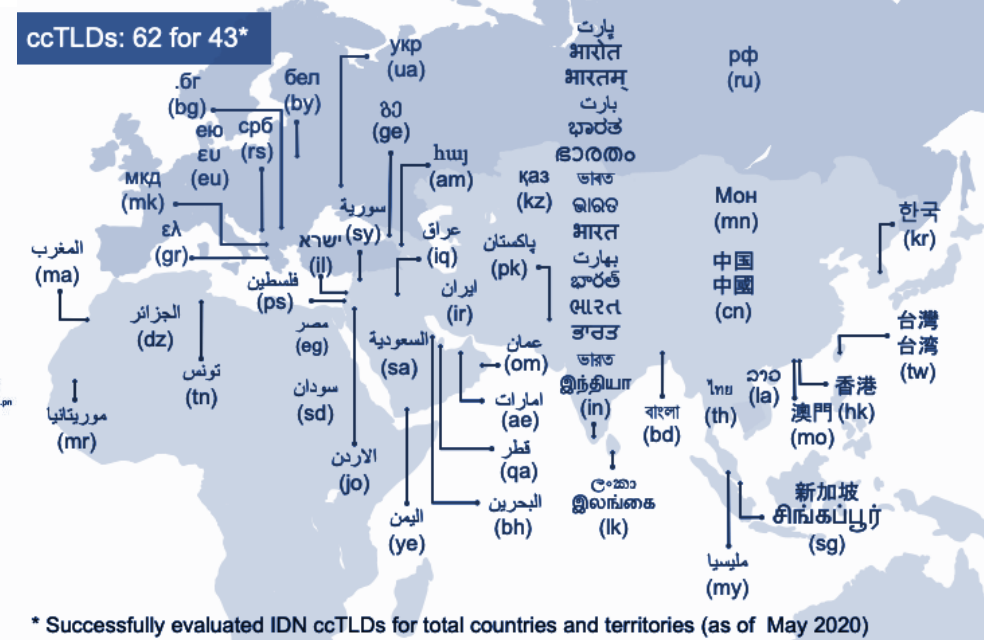
Introduction to the ccNSO

What does ccNSO stand for?

- **ccNSO:** Country Code Names Supporting Organization (within ICANN)
 - Created for and by ccTLD managers
- **ccTLD manager:** organization or entity responsible for managing a ccTLD
- **ccTLD:** country code top-level domain

Evolve the global policies that serve ccTLDs in the ICANN environment, consistent with ccNSO values and the needs of ccTLDs.

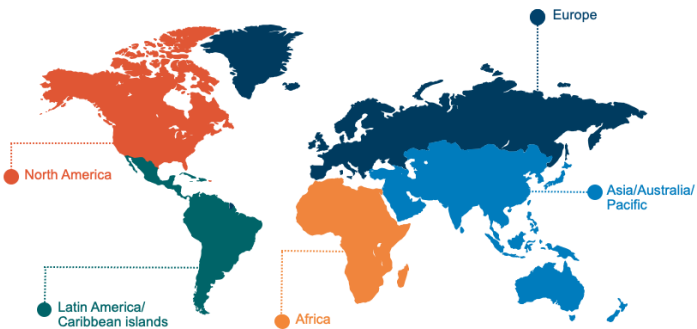
Cooperate and learn

Contribute to ICANN's broader work on its core mission and responsibilities, to advance ccTLD perspectives and interests.

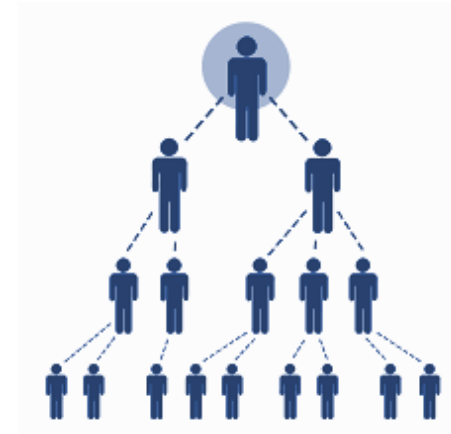

Region



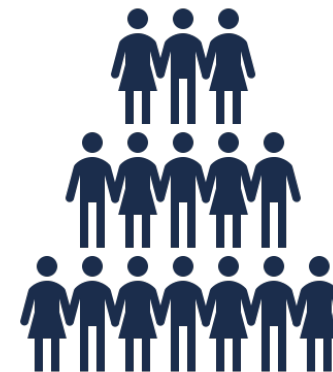
Governance Model

Composition of the ccNSO

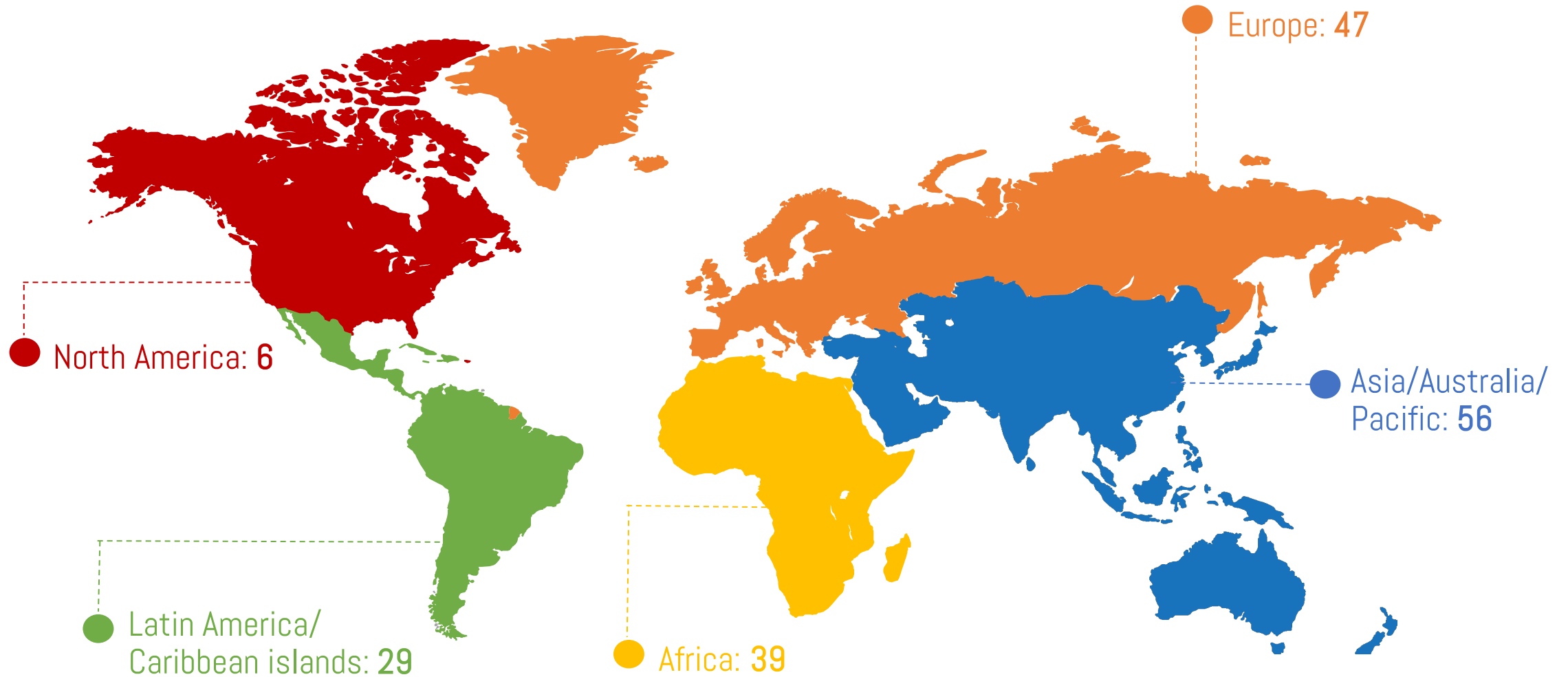
Composition of the ccNSO

177 ccNSO members (1 July 2024)



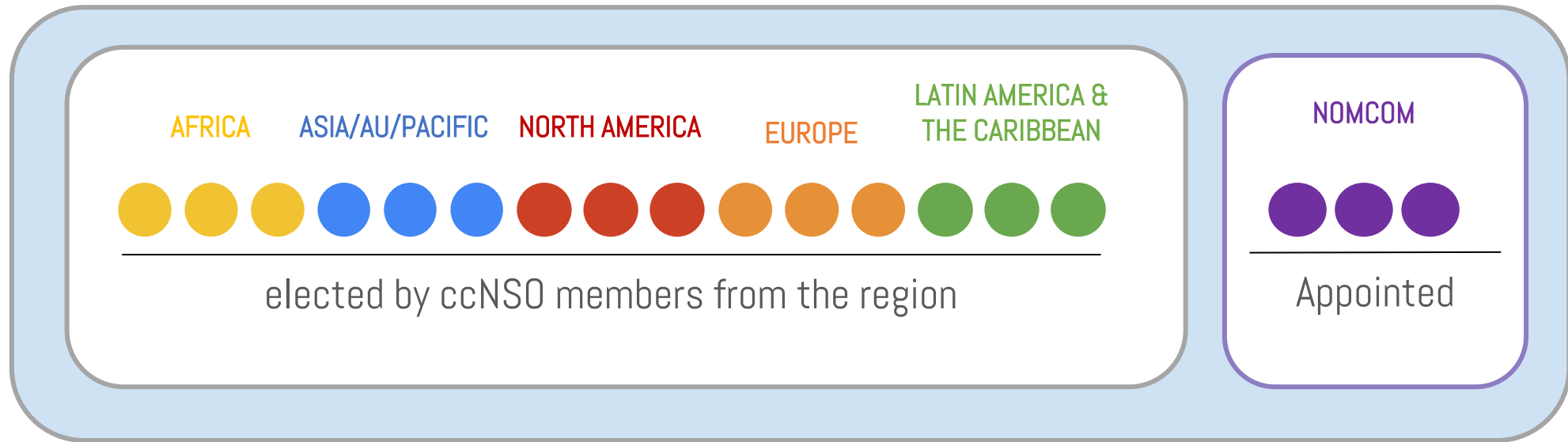
Benefits for ccNSO Members

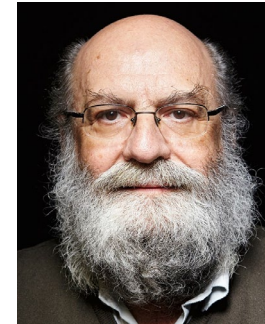

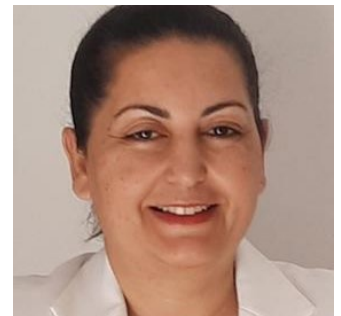

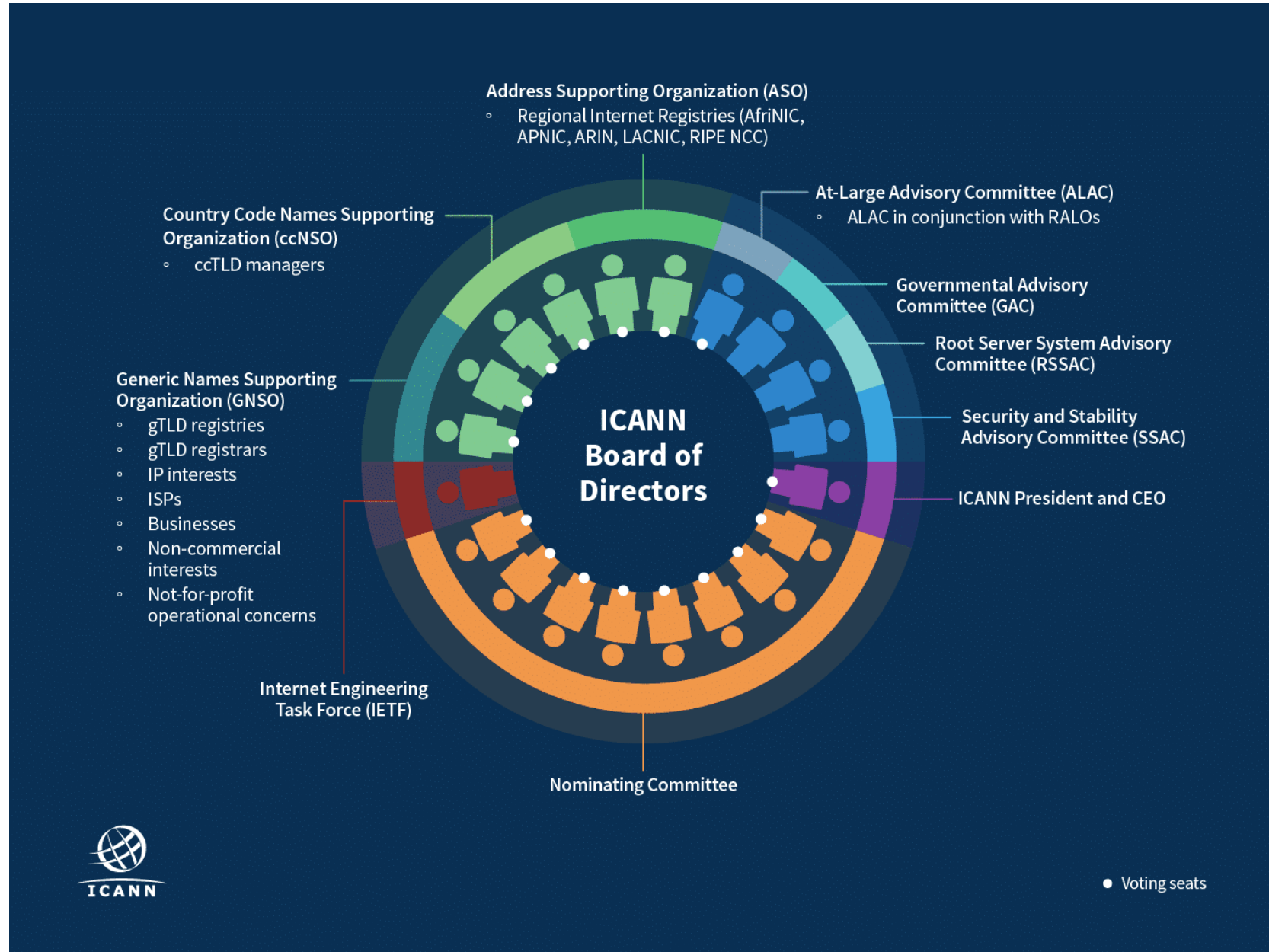
