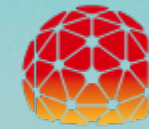

1. Catchy title

Reviewers are scoring 300+ proposals, how you do make yours stand out? How do you make the audience want to come to your workshop?

2. Topic

What are you passionate about?

Who is your audience?

Where does it fit in the main theme/subthemes?

3. Scope

Ask the right policy questions.

How to frame questions neutrally but still drive the direction of the discussion.

Balance between broad and specific.

4. Format

What is the one that best suits your topic?

How to manage the moderator and panelists?

How to handle audience interaction?

How to engage remote participants?

Additional online tools?

5. Diversity matters

Stakeholder, Points of View, Geographic,
Gender, Newcomers vs. Experts

No echo chamber

No tokenism

Building a good panel gives you a basis for a
substantive discussion.

6. Speakers
