Topic 2	 Most ICANN community groups have an existing working group or process dedicated to continuous improvement (14 out of the 21 groups represented in the CIP-CCG reported thus far). Several ICANN community groups have new or existing continuous improvement activities stemming from prior Organizational Reviews (ex. ALAC, SSAC, RSSAC).
	One group recently conducted a survey of its members specifically devoted to the continuous improvement of their structure (GNSO Council's CCOICI), and will discuss the results of the survey during the ICANN79 Community Forum.
	 Several groups noted challenges/opportunities in gathering consistent performance metrics in their structure, as well as promoting awareness of ICANN issues, including policy issues (ex. ALAC, ccNSO, GNSO Council).
	The GAC representative noted its acute challenge of membership turnover and related knowledge transfer, as its membership completely rotates on a regular basis. It has established several activities to provide capacity building and continuity, to orient government representatives to the complex work of ICANN and the evolving geopolitical context.
	The GNSO Council representative noted the challenge they are attempting to address, of determining how to proceed when a group is unable to reach consensus on certain recommendations and/or decisions.
	 Several groups noted the significance of both global ICANN and regional ICANN engagement and representation (ex: ALAC, RALOs, ccNSO).
