Recommendation:

- Cross community training programme on ICANN issues
- Implemented in the schedule in every ICANN meeting (1-3 Days)
- Obligation for incoming ALAC, GAC...representatives and fellows BEFORE their term starts (one meeting in advance)
- Faculty within the ICANN community (registrars, board member, staff, ALAC, GAC)

- 1. Develop the existing approach of beginners session (like DNSSEC or new gTLDs for beginners)
- 2. Start in San Francisco with a one day programme
- 3.Learn from the experience
- 4.Improve and establish
