


* ICANN maintains a Policy Publish Schedule where ICANN and SOs contribute updates to a Policy Publish Schedule
 * Each entry in the Policy Publish Schedule should have the name of the policy, an excerpt of what the policy statement is about ; the SO responsible and a tentative date for completion (before translation)
 * At some specified regular interval - (say every month for example), the SOs are made aware of the policies underway
 * An SO can then request further details and/or a briefing call to better understand the draft policy
 * ICANN Translation Dept are kept up to date on the Policy Publish Schedule so that they can plan and allocate translation resources
 * When policy is complete, Translation Dept translates the document into Spanish and French (and other requested languages)

Policy is available for comment

At most 10 days after policy is available for comment

At most 21 days or 36 days (if 15 day extension is granted) after policy is available for comment

At most 23 days or 38 days (if 15 day extension is granted) after policy is available for comment

At most 29 days or 44 days (if 15 day extension is granted) after policy is available for comment
