

Report of Negotiation Session on the Registrar Accreditation Agreement (27 Jan 2012)

Location: Telephone Conference

Issues Discussed:

- Discussion of Law Enforcement Recommendations and Status of Registrar Consensus-Building.
 - In anticipation of ICANN's upcoming meeting with Law Enforcement Agency (LEA) representatives, reviewed each of the twelve LEA recommendations published at the Seoul ICANN meeting to assess progress in negotiating toward the 12 targets.
- Discussion of Timing for Next Meetings:
 - The next telephone conference is to be held on either 2 or 3 February, with an additional face-to-face meeting proposed for 9 and 10 February in Washington, D.C., which may also include a joint session with LEA or the GAC.
