Issues Discussed:

• The Registrar negotiation team provided ICANN with an overview of the revisions requested in the latest Registrar redline of the base agreement, and the rationale for the Registrar requests.

- Registrars provided initial feedback on the law enforcement's recent clarifications with regard to data retention and maintenance of information.
 - Registrars noted concerns about length of retention period, and questioned whether they were consistent with data protection laws from varying jurisdictions.
