

Report of Negotiation Session on the Registrar Accreditation Agreement (13 Aug 2012)

Issues Discussed:

- The participants identified individuals willing to explore the parameters of a privacy/proxy accreditation program and to develop a strawman proposal for community consultation.
- Discussion of a GAG engagement to clarify the law enforcement related requests with regard to any data privacy concerns.
- The participants then discussed the verification request, including
 - Continued Registrar SG concerns with a model that requires pre-resolution verification, including the concerns of the Registry SG should this model be required.
 - Discussion on identifying the minimal baseline level of verification that could receive the support of the Registrar SG, with a commitment to continue working on the issue through consultation with the community and engagement in the policy processes.
- Request for a formal Registrar response on the WHOIS SLA and Registrar Operation Specifications.
- Discussion of the WHOIS RT Final Report recommendations and whether the revisions to the RAA discussed to date are consistent with the WHOIS RT Final Report.
- Upcoming Meetings:
 - Proposed Teleconference on the week of Aug 20th; Planning for a two days of face-to-face meetings in mid-September.
