

Report of Negotiation Session on the Registrar Accreditation Agreement (18 July 2012)

Location: Telephone Conference Call

Issues Discussed:

- The participants discussed the comments received during the Prague Meeting in an effort to identify how to wrap up some of the outstanding issues
- **Validation/Verification-**
 - The Registrars reiterated that they are willing to do e-mail or phone verification, but not both
 - The participants explored whether the law enforcement representatives were still seeking annual re-verification, but would instead seek verification at the time of payments associated with the domain name (i.e., initial registration or renewal)
 - Discussion of whether having pre-resolution verification would help reduce crimes; Registrars to provide analysis on the effectiveness of pre-resolution verification
- **Proxy/Privacy Accreditation Program**
 - The participants discussed comments heard in Prague encouraging ICANN to immediately begin the process of creating the framework for a proxy/privacy accreditation program
 - The participants agreed to identify volunteers to try to develop an outline for a process/framework for creating an accreditation program;
- **Obtaining Input of Data Protection Experts**
 - The participants discussed how to work with the GAC to seek input from data protection experts with regard to certain of the law enforcement related recommendations
