



INTRODUCTION

- Sri Lankan UA LI launched on 5th of December 2022.
- We also started our first three day workshop on 28th & 29th of November and on the 5th December, we have policy workshop. For the workshop held in 28th & 29th more than thirty participated.
- ☐ These participants included Engineers from the leading Internet Service providers in Sri Lanka such as SLT Mobitel and Dialog.
- Senior Officers from ICTA, Dialog, SLT and Academia participated in the policy workshop.
- ☐ Champika Wijayatunga, ICANN's Regional Technical Engagement Manager for Asia Pacific Regions and I carried out the training.

PRESS CONFERENCE

- On the 5th of December 2022, we had a very successful press conference and almost all media institutions carried it as news within several days.
- □ Lakehouse which is the oldest Newspaper publisher carried several news items in their front pages in Sinhala and English dailies.
- Lakehouse became the first newspaper company to launch IDNs for Sinhala and Tamil newspapers.




UNIVERSAL ACCEPTANCE WEBSITE

- ☐ The second workshop was also held on 24th & 25th of January where Theekhana unveiled the first ever email platform.
- Theekshana developed email platform using Postfix, Dovecot, and Roundcube.
- ☐ Theekshana also worked on many different Mail clients such as MUTT, etc.







- India is one of the **biggest consumers of data** around the world and we are the **world's second-largest telecommunications**, as well as the **App market**.






FICCI-ILIA and Local India Chapter
