## Brief presentation of Abdelaziz Hilali

Dr. Abdelaziz Hilali is a professor at the Moroccan telecommunications graduate institution (INPT) (www.inpt.ac.ma). He graduated from the Joseph Fourier University of Grenoble, France where he earned a PhD in applied mathematics and computer science in 1987. He prepared this degree within the "Computer Algebra" team of the applied mathematics and computer science department.

Following his graduation, he has published a number of scientific papers and given a substantial number of oral presentations at international meetings.

Dr. Hilali has been a member of the ministerial commission in charge of the launching of the program of the master's in Telecommunications and ICT engineering. He was in charge of student academic affairs, including job placements within private and in 1996. He is a Founder of the Moroccan IPv6Task Force (June 2006). He is member of the Multistakeholder Advisory Committee (MAG) and currently the president elect of the Mediterranean Federation of Internet Associations (Tunis 2007) (<a href="www.fmai.org">www.fmai.org</a>),
