

Oksana Prykhodko is the director of iNGO European Media Platform with the mission of the promotion of European standards in media and information society.

Mrs. Prykhodko has been involved in Internet Governance since 2006, when she as a journalist was invited by the Council of Europe to the First IGF in Athens. In 2008 she participated in the work of the Council of Europe group of experts on human rights in the information society, in 2009 graduated EuroSSIG, in 2010 – Diplo Foundation Internet Governance Capacity Building Program, in 2011 – ICANN Fellowship Program. Participated in three editions of IGF and in all editions of EuroDIG (last time – as a core team member and co-organizer of the workshop on hate speech). In May 2011 was elected as a secretariat of EURALO. Participated in IDN Variants Working Group, now is the member of ICANN Academia Working Group. She is the moderator of the initiative group of ISOC Ukraine Chapter.

Mrs. Prykhodko is the co-organizer of the EuroDIG remote participation hub in Kiev, the First and Second Ukrainian Internet Governance Forum, the series of the round tables in Ukrainian Parliament (“Implementation of media points of PACE and European Parliament resolutions on Ukraine”, “Ukraine’s integration into the European information society”, “Governance of information society critical resources in Ukraine”). She is the author of more than 1 500 journalistic articles and about dozen of scientific articles.
