Background	The NCPH has encountered challenges with the timely appointment of a candidate to Board seat 14 pursuant to <u>Annex 7</u> of the GNSO Operating Procedures. Team 14 was established to discuss the problem and determine if any changes are needed to the process.
Scope of the effort	 Team 14 has agreed to discuss and review the following topics in the hopes of building understanding and potentially evolving the NCPH process of selecting a candidate for appointment to Board seat 14 in a manner that meets the needs of both sides of the house as well as the needs of the Board. Team 14 will 1. Discuss lessons learned from the last time Board seat 14 was appointed a. Share stakeholder group perceptions and identify key areas of challenge 2. Discuss possible updates to procedures to help avoid missing the deadline to appoint a candidate to Board seat 14 3. Discuss possible joint interview process, not to the exclusion of individual stakeholder group interviews in order to avoid perfunctory "no thank you" responses to proposed candidates 4. Discuss establishing performance review criteria for the Board seat 14 occupant 5. If time allows, discuss memorializing a procedure for the timely selection of GNSO Council Vice Chair (this work will be completed after the Board seat 14 work is done)
