

UNGA Resolution Geneva | First Phase 56/183 endorsed Geneva Declaration of holding WSIS in Principles, Geneva Plan of Action.

WGIG formed **Tunis** | Second Phase with 40 members. Tunis Commitment. First meeting heldTunis Agenda, WGIG in Geneva. Report and IGF est.

UNGA HLM on outcomes of WSIS. WSIS+10 Outcome document and IGF mandate renewal.

**UNGA** WSIS+20 Review.

#### To Summarize

2025 will mark the 20th anniversary of the World Summit of the Information Society (WSIS). The WSIS process was pivotal in gaining U.N. Member States' endorsement to the multistakeholder model of Internet governance. The multistakeholder model is critical for the continued development of a secure and interoperable Internet. Continuation of WSIS will be determined by the U.N. General Assembly (UNGA) in 2025.



## **WSIS Updates**

#### GDC Zero Draft

- The technical community is recognized as a separate stakeholder, and not part of any other stakeholder group.
- The Multistakeholder model of Internet governance and the Internet Governance Forum are supported in several different instances.
- The creation of the multilateral Digital Cooperation Forum is not supported.

- High Level Event (27-31 May)
  - Co-Organized by ITU, UNESCO, UNCTAD, and UNDP
  - Serves as platform for multistakeholder discussions
  - ICANN Workshop: Digital inclusivity Connecting the next billion (29 May; 1000 Local)
- Al for Good Global Summit 2024 (30-31 May)
