Proposed Update to Recommendation 7 by the New gTLD Auction Proceeds
Cross-Community Working Group (CCWG-AP)

This correspondence by the At-Large Advisory Committee (ALAC) is in response to the letter to the SO/AC Chairs dated 2 March 2024 from ICANN Board's Chair Tripti Sinha, regarding the Proposed Update to Recommendation 7 by the New gTLD Auction Proceeds Cross-Community Working Group (CCWG-AP).

The letter was discussed by the members of the At-Large Operations, Finance, and Budget Working Group (OFB-WG) on 21 March 2024 and 28 March 2024. The OFB-WG discussed the draft response summarizing the position of the membership on this matter.
