Round 1-ccTLD manager to only be part of the ccNSO. Are there other people who can be of help in the ccNSO & who? Is there a different way to structure the ccNSO? This question needs to be posed for improvement, the answer could be no. Current mission for ccNSO says this org consists of ccTLD managers and working for ccTLD management. This is a limiting statement. Is there a place for others in the market? Yes, there is a value. This is a job for individual registries to some extent, maybe regional organizations.

How is ccNSO running now? What are the positives if we include more than ccTLD managers? Have a set of questions we ask every few years. The questions may evolve. Is it time for this type of change? Keep reviewing.

ccNSO there is only a representative per ccTLD. Other groups have more representatives per group. Should this be changed for ccNSO?

This is more of a question for the Holistic Review.
