Roles

The officers of AFRALO are a Chairperson, a Vice Chairperson and a **Secretariat**.

- **AFRALO Secretary**

- He/She shall be elected by the Members of AFRALO and shall serve a term of office of two years.
- He or she shall deal with all questions concerning the administration of the Organization.
- He or she shall particularly prepare the AFRALO meetings agenda in close collaboration with the Chairperson and deal with application for membership.
- He or she shall also manage actively AFRALO mailing list(s), and disseminate AFRALO and ICANN related news, requests for comments on any policy development issues to AFRALO members through the mailing list(s) in a timely manner

Roles

At-Large Advisory Committee (ALAC) roles.

- **ALAC Member**

- The ALAC shall consist of two members selected by each of the Regional At-Large Organizations (RALOs) established according to Section 12.2(d)(vii)
- Delegates are expected to actively participate in all aspects of the Committee's work. This includes some qualitative commitments and quantitative requirements.
 - Qualitative: Participating in activities, providing feedback on matters, serving as a liaison to the public, etc
 - Quantitative: Casting votes on ALS accreditation, attend $\frac{2}{3}$ calls in 6 month period, etc

- **ALAC Voting Delegate to the NomCom**

- Five members selected by the Nominating Committee. (one for each geographic region)
- The NomCom is responsible for selecting members of the ICANN Board, ALAC, ccNSO and GNSO. This is a very important function and all candidates should meet important criteria.

AFRALO Selection Timetable for 2024*

- 15 April 2024 - Announcement of call for nominations and Nominee's Statement.*
- 15 April – 26 April 2024 - Nomination period (nominations accepted for 10 working days).
- 3 May 2024 - Deadline for nomination acceptances
- **6 May 2024 - 9 May 2024- Calls with the candidates if desired by the RALOs.**
- 10 May - 24 May 2024 - Elections (If required, elections will begin no later than one week after the deadline for nomination acceptances and end no later than two weeks after that deadline).
- 2024 AGM [ICANN81] - Newly elected ALAC Members and RALOs Leaders shall be seated at the end of the 2024 AGM following the close of the Board Meeting on 14 November 2024.
