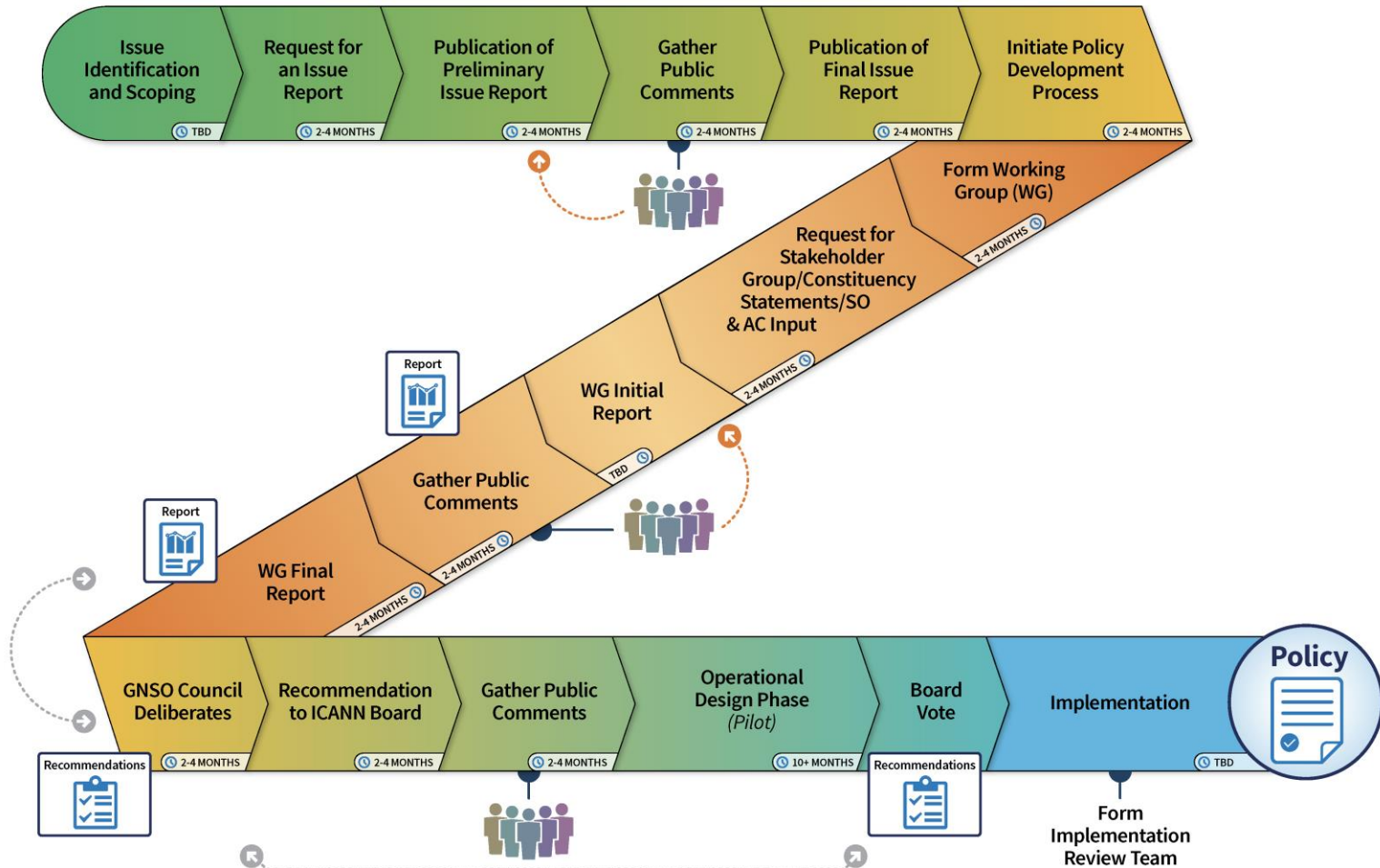

Highlight: EPDP on Internationalized Domain Names

(Selected for highlighting)

- ⦿ Phase 2 Initial Report public comment: 11 April – 21 May 2024
 - “Same entity” at the second-level and IDN Table harmonization
 - Adjustments in registry agreement, registry service, registry transition process, and other processes/procedures related to the domain name lifecycle
 - Adjustments in registration dispute-resolution procedures and trademark protection mechanisms
 - Process to update the IDN Implementation Guidelines

Subsequent Procedures Supplemental Recommendations

- ⦿ In April 2024, GNSO Council
 - Approved supplemental recommendations (“Supp Recs”) on 4 of 6 remaining topics
 - (i) Topic 9: Registry Voluntary Commitments / Public Interest Commitments re: Rec 9.2
 - **(ii) Topic 17: Applicant Support re: Rec 17.2**
 - (iii) Topic 18: Terms and Conditions re: Recs 18.1 & 18.3;, and
 - (iv) Topic 32: Limited Challenge/Appeal Mechanisms re: Recs 32.1, 32.3 & 32.10.
 - Determined that supp rec not needed for (v) Topic 22: Registrant Protections re: Rec 22.7 on Continued Operations Instrument (COI)
 - **Deferred approving supp recs on (vii) Topic 24: String Similarity Evaluations**
- ⦿ Why the deferral on Topic 24 Supp Recs?
 - To allow SubPro Small Team Plus to consider **ICANN Org’s strawman proposal on how to handle issue of Singular/Plural strings.**
 - Join the discussion on Singular/Plural strings at CPWG call

Diacritics in Latin Script

- History
 - In 2012 Round, applicants opted to apply for ASCII strings (without diacritics) even though allowed to apply for strings with diacritics
 - No pursuit of “formal” remedy until 4 public comments re: “.québec” submitted to IDNs EPDP Phase 1 Initial Report in April 2023
 - IDNs EPDP considered this as ‘out of scope’ since .quebec and .québec are not variant labels per RZ-LGR
 - GNSO Council has considered issue since July 2023, including ALAC Chair’s letter to GNSO Chair of 22 June 2023.
 - Council received detailed briefing in Oct 2023 and agreed to request a study from ICANN org; ICANN org proposed alternate way
 - **In April 2024, Council received and rejected ICANN Org’s proposal**
 - **In May 2024, Council resolved to request for an Issues Report, directing staff to create the Report**

- **Next Step:** Wait for GNSO Support Staff to produce Issue Report

- ⦿ Applicant Guide Book
 - 7 topics underwent 1st public comment proceeding: 1 Feb – 19 Mar 2024
 - ALAC comment: [AL-ALAC-ST-0224-01-00-EN](#)

- ⦿ **Applicant Support Program Handbook**
 - Underwent public comment proceeding: 12 Feb – 15 Apr 2024
 - ALAC comment: [AL-ALAC-ST-0224-02-01-EN](#)

- ⦿ Registry Service Provider Handbook
 - Underwent public comment proceeding: 13 Mar – 22 Apr 2024
 - ALAC did not comment

- ⦿ String Similarity Review Guidelines
 - Underwent public comment proceeding: 7 Feb – 10 Apr 2024
 - ALAC comment: [AL-ALAC-ST-0224-02-00-EN](#)

- ⦿ Strawman proposal regarding Singular/Plural strings
 - Being discussed by GNSO SubPro Small Team Plus
 - Being discussed by At-Large at CPWG calls

- ⦿ **New gTLD Program Outreach and Engagement Plan**

⦿ Program Implementation

- Applicant Support Program Handbook public comment – SubPro IRT ASP Subtrack only resuming calls on 21 May
 - Incorporation of 14 SubPro policy recommendations & implementation guidance
 - Incorporation of 9 guidance recommendations from GNSO Guidance Process on ASP
- Supplemental Recommendation 17.2 yet to be considered by ICANN Board
- Still no ICANN announcement on ASP Funding Plan
 - gTLD string application fee amount
 - ASP operations – staff, pro bono services providers, Support Application Review Panels

◎ Program Highlights

- Application period: 12 months from Q4 2024 – Q4 2025; preceding New gTLD string application period targeted for Q2 2026
- Evaluation in 2 phases, across 5 evaluation categories:
 - Phase 1 – General Business Due Diligence
 - Phase 2 –
 - Public Responsibility Due Diligence:
 - Financial Need
 - Financial Stability
 - Eligible Entities – criterion, indicators, documentary requirements
 1. Non-profits, charities, or equivalent
 2. Intergovernmental organizations
 3. Indigenous/tribal people’s organizations
 4. Social Impact or Public benefit micro or small business
 5. Micro or small sized business from a less-developed economy

⦿ Program Highlights (Cont'd)

○ Types of support - Both financial and non-financial

- ASP training program (subject to Supplemental Recommendation 17.2)
- Access to pro-bono services providers, independent from / not endorsed or contracted by ICANN org
- ICANN org to play facilitative role, making applicants aware of services
- ICANN org to identify service providers who have volunteered services
- Resources and info for potential applicants to understand New gTLD Program, what it means to operate a gTLD, how to participate in ICANN's multistakeholder community
- Access to Application Counselors (subject to Supplemental Recommendation 17.2)
- A 50-85% reduction in New gTLD Program application and evaluation fees for supported applicants
- A bid credit or multiplier for supported applicants participating in ICANN Auction of Last Resort to resolve contention set.
- Reduced or waived base Registry Operator fees for supported applicant that prevails and proceeds to contracting and delegation (subject to Supplemental Recommendation 17.2)
