In my current role at NIC.br and previous role at the Federation of Industries of the State of Paraná, I gained experience in legal aspects of evaluating, drafting, and updating internal policies to achieve institutional improvements. Additionally, my board service in various national and international (small-sized) organizations involved regularly assessing operational and administrative effectiveness. My ICANN involvement is relatively new; I started actively participating in meetings from the beginning of 2023 as a Nextgen, with some previous online work in public comments and a fellowship on the beginning of 2024. However, right after my Nextgen Experience, I was elected to the NCUC EC (LAC representative) in September 2023 and since then I've been using my legal background and diverse Internet Governance knowledge to contribute to more public comments and work related to ICANN policies and frameworks. While I may not possess specific expertise in data optimization for large institutions, my experience in analyzing data to inform decision-making in smaller organizations translates well to ICANN's complex environment.

I intend to have more impacts in the ICANN ecosystem, promoting not only non-commercial interests, but also an overall improvement in the organization's approach to seeking consensus and balance within the multistakeholder model. In the national, regional, and international spaces I've always worked with diverse teams and frequently in leadership position (such as the Youth LACIGF, ISOC Youth SIG, IGF Youth Summit, the Brazilian and Portuguese Academia, ISOC Brasil, Creative Commons Brasil, and Rights in Network Coalition). In these initiatives, I've consistently been seen as someone who works to find solutions that bridge diverse – and sometimes even antagonistic – positions, possessing the ability to navigate conflict while pursuing goals within set timeframes. After writing a few public comments, assisting others in ICANN policy-making processes and working intensively on an IRT, I believe it's time to take on more impactful roles directly. Within this scope, the Policy Holder Representative (PHR) role will be my priority, and I'm dedicating at least two slots in my monthly schedule to this work.
