SPEAKER: I don't know. Abiola, do you want to take the floor? Do you have any

comment on what Tijani and myself said, just said? Abiola, do you have

any comments? No comments?

FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA: Fatimata is speaking. I'd like to ask Abiola about Nigeria, if he is the only

person from Nigeria.

ADETOKUNBO ABIOLA: Yeah, we can work online on the capacity building. So I think our ideas

should be what we need, but that's more or less the thing about it – the

ability to complete it and to do that (inaudible) our comments.

FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA: Abiola, we can't hear you. We can't understand what you are saying.

ADETOKUNBO ABIOLA: I said that we are not doing work online, that the capacity building. We

have got to [build ideas] (inaudible) for the capacity building. Can you

hear me?

HEIDI ULLRICH: Abiola, this is Heidi. I can hear you, I'm not sure the others can. If I'm

correct in hearing what you're saying, you're saying it's important to

work online to identify the items, the topics for the capacity building. Is

that correct? We're going to unmute you in just one moment.

FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA: Fatimata speaking. She would like to know whether he's from Nigeria.

ADETOKUNBO ABIOLA: I'm from Nigeria. Yes, I'm from Nigeria.

HEIDI ULLRICH: Okay, thank you. So you're confirming that basically the way forward is

to work online to identify the topics for capacity building.

ADETOKUNBO ABIOLA: Yes.

HEIDI ULLRICH: Okay, [that's a response] to Tijani. We're going to mute you again.

FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA: Okay, that's no big deal.

HEIDI ULLRICH: Fatimata and Tijani, this is Heidi – may I make a comment?

FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA: No, I have no further comments. Tijani, do you want to take the floor?

TIJANI BEN JEMAA:

Thank you, it's Tijani speaking. I would just like to know that the sections we have discussed are important and I think maybe we have not announced this with sufficient advance. We work a lot, we have to work very tight. We wanted to have this session before the IGF in Baku but we will have to do it online now and I hope we'll get good feedback. And I simply wanted to thank Naela and Nigel and of course Silvia and Heidi as well. I am really sorry that only Abiola showed up.

**FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA:** 

Yes, I am very disappointed about that, too, and I would also like to thank the staff, so Nigel, Naela, Silvia and Heidi.

NIGEL HICKSON:

This is Nigel. Sorry, it's always nice to join in. I hope we can come up with some good ideas and we'd be very happy to take them forward.

**NAELA SARRAS:** 

This is Naela. I'd like to agree with Nigel, absolutely. This is good for us and hopefully we can get some concrete ideas that we can follow up on.

**HEIDI ULLRICH:** 

Thank you, Naela, this is Heidi. Just maybe as a certain point to move forward, on the Wiki page that has been set up — and I'm going to put that into the Adobe Connect now — but I see that we already have four topics of sessions that were held in Dakar, and those were again to repeat ICANN's role in the structure of the internet, "ICANN Within the Internet Ecosystem." The second one was "ICANN's Mission, Structure, and Constituencies" — that was more towards how ICANN works. Then

we had a presentation by the Policy staff on how AFRALO could help shape the future of the internet by working with various groups within the Policy Department; and then we had Naela give us an update on the IDNs. So I wonder if we can agree that we're going to keep those and then perhaps add one or two more topics, so maybe a total of five or six topics to move forward. Can we agree on that, Tijani and Fatimata?

TIJANI BEN JEMAA:

Yes, can I speak, Fatimata?

**FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA:** 

Yes, go on.

TIJANI BEN JEMAA:

Tijani speaking. Heidi, I'm very glad to see that old presentations are on the Wiki even if we're not going to go through them and to use them. It's better to have them on the Wiki so that people can access those presentations, so that they can decide what the use of having them would be and whether it'd be more useful or not.

**FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA:** 

Fatimata speaking. Thank you, Tijani. Thank you, Heidi. I think back on what we discussed in Toronto. We should begin to work. We need some capacity building and we need to choose the items for this capacity building.

**HEIDI ULLRICH:** 

So this is Heidi. If I might just suggest that we work, that the At-Large staff work with you, Fatimata and Tijani, to get the topics maybe by the end of November and then we can have another call early December to move forward with staff. Would that be a way forward?

**FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA:** 

Fatimata speaking. I'm okay. For me it's okay. Personally I think it's a very good idea. Let's try to choose the subjects of the capacity building training and we can try to organize another meeting for the beginning of December. Tijani, do you agree with that? Tijani, you have the floor.

TIJANI BEN JEMAA:

I agree, it's okay for me. I have no objection about that.

**FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA:** 

Okay. For the next action item, for the next meeting we are going to try to contact everybody, the ALSes; ask them to go on the Wiki page and try to see all the material on the Wiki page, and tell us what are the subjects they need to deepen. And Tijani and myself, we are going to work to summarize what we have done and on our next meeting, and we will organize a next meeting and the date for another meeting. Is this okay? Everybody agrees?

NIGEL HICKSON:

Yes, yes. It's good for me, yes.

FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA: Tijani? Do you have some questions? Okay, if you all agree I think it's...

Nigel, you have something to say? If Nigel has something to add?

NIGEL HICKSON: No, I'm fine as long as we can identify some positive items or some

positive issues where training is required then we can discuss the better

modalities in terms of supplying that. So yeah, thank you very much.

FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA: Thank you very much, Nigel. Heidi or Naela, do you have any

comments?

NAELA SARRAS: Not at this time, thank you. No.

FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA: Thank you. Heidi, do you want to have any comments?

HEIDI ULLRICH: No, I think that's it. I think we made good progress today, thank you.

Are we ending, Fatimata? This is Heidi.

FATIMATA SEYE SYLLA: Okay, yes, Fatimata speaking. Yes, we are ending. Thank you,

everybody. Okay, thank you everybody. Thank you, Heidi, thank you

Silvia. Thank you Claire, Abiola and Tijani, and thank you Nigel, thank

you everybody. See you later.
