Further notes:in the context of variant domain name management for EPDP-IDNs, exempted ion means that there will be no change to the contractual and allocation status of existing variant domain names that do not conform to the “same entity” principle, as recommended by the EPDP-IDNs Team. The requirement of having the same registrant and the same sponsoring registrar will not be applied retroactively. Appropriately, the exempted variant domain names are also excluded from the additional requirements relating to the “same entity”

principle This also implies that the exemption period will end when one registrant and one sponsoring registrar remain for the variant domain set, which would effectively allow for further allocation.
