Motivation for ATRT2

My candidature is motivated by a desire to bring to ATRT2 a broad experience acquired in positions of responsibility, both within and outisde ICANN.

- 1) Within ICANN. During my service as a Member of the Board of Directors (2007-10), I was one of those actively involved in the greatest number of Board committees and working groups. This provided an overview of the challenges ICANN has to face, as well as a good knowledge of the processes and structures of ICANN. As one of the co-authors of the document on « Improving Institutional Confidence » made public in 2009 by the President's Strategy Committee http://archive.icann.org/en/jpa/iic/iic-the-way-forward-31may09-en.pdf, I am familiar with its set of recommendations, some of which were later taken up in the « Affirmation of Commitments ». Currently a member of the ALAC, my work is focused on the global public interest, on the improvement of accountability and transparency, and on the future challenges facing the global Internet and ICANN.

In addition, my association with research and tutoring in top institutions, provided useful background to my later volunteer work at ICANN.
