#### Vision of Zaid Ali

Forming the San Francisco Bay Area Silicon Valley Internet Society Chapter was a vision of Zaid Ali. Zaid worked with Franck Martin for many years dating back to a time they were instrumental in networking Fiji, and bringing the island nation online. Years later they both worked in Silicon Valley and began recruiting chapter members in the valley. Several applications for approval from Global ISOC were attempted.

### **History:**

- 2011: Created as the SFBayISOC InterPlanetary Network (IPN) project, to work closely with the already established IPN (ipn.org).
- 2013: Applied for ISOC chapter formation.
- 2014: Space Technology Innovations Conference, "Enabling Exploration Above—Improving Life Below" at Google HQ in Mountain View, Jan/24
- 2014: ISOC Chapter formation approved.
- ISOC-IPN is not an At-Large Structure (ALS) at this time. A proposal may be submitted in the future, with special focus on potential members from the Aerospace and Space Sciences communities.

### Mission:

• The mission of the InterPlanetary Networking Special Interest Group (IPNSIG) is to realize a functional and scalable system of interplanetary data communications before the year 2020.
