- 1. Measurements Document
 - Terry Manderson provides an overview of the Measurements Document (RSSAC-002).

 - Elise Gerich provides further context indicating that the goal is not to do more than 1,000 new gTLDs per year.
 - Barbara Roseman seconds the statement and gives further information on what staff is working on with the roll-out.
 - LJL expresses concern over how delegation is managed.
 - Russ asks if there is any indication on the rate of approval of new gTLDs.
 - Elise responds that 20 per week is the expectation.
 - RSSAC community requests more information from ICANN about pace of new gTLD delegation.

- Elise Gerich indicates that she would like to see the measurements document implemented.
- LJL states that there is a willingness to provide measurement information among root operators.
