- + No longer a side issue!
- + When politicians are involved?
- + We need to have common understanding

- + The CSTD WG on Enhanced Cooperation
- + IGF Mandate



WSIS+10 Review

- + Paragraph 111 of Tunis Agenda
- + UN mandate to ITU, UNDP etc
- + UNESCO Conference (1st Summit)
- + ITU Summit planned for April
- + Final form of "Review" Summit to be determined in UNGA (March 2014)



CSTD WG on "Enhanced Cooperation"

- + EC as term of Art (Tunis Agenda again)
- + Issue on whether "operational" or not
- + CSTD WG looking at evidence for "enhanced cooperation" in practice
- + Pivotal issue for WSIS



Internet Governance Forum (IGF) Mandate

- + IGF established under Tunis Agenda
- + Has revolutionized IG; spawned regional and national fora
- + Mandate extended in 2015 for 5 years
- + Up for renewal in 2015 after Istanbul (2014) and Brazil (2015)



ITU Strand

- + An evolutionary approach
- + WCIT in December 2012
- WTPF last May (on Internet Governance)
- + WTDC in April 2014 in UAE
- + Plenipotentiary (PP-14) in Oct/Nov in Busan; Korea



Why PP-14 important?

- + Significant elections of Secretary General, Deputy and others;
- + Opportunity (every 4 years) to change Constitution (such as scope);
- + Internet Governance will be a key issue
- + Key opportunity?

- + Conference on Internet Governance in San Paulo; Brazil; 23-24 April;

- + Key opportunity to debate IG in climate of reduced trust in governmental institutions
